Our History in Turkey

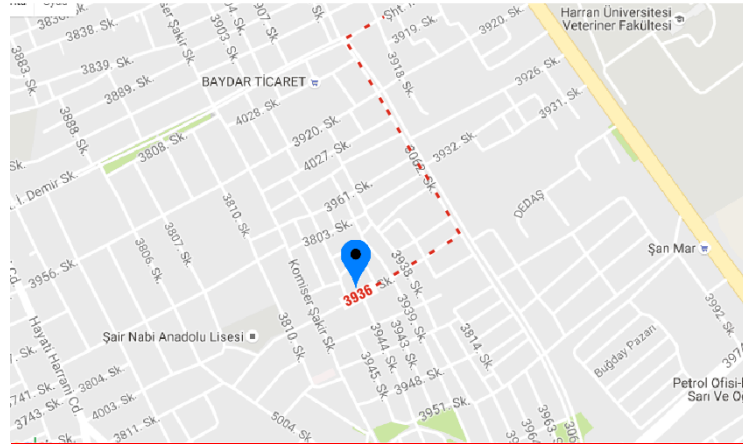
In Turkey, we started our activities following Van earthquake, which hit eastern Turkey on 23 October 2011. AAR Japan dispatched an emergency response team and has delivered food and other basic humanitarian needs for the vulnerable population in Van province. Apart from that, we provided medical devices support for the persons with disabilities.

We have been working for Syrians refugees since 2012, in Turkey. We implemented food assistance, assistance for persons with disabilities, educational support and clothes for winter conditions in Hatay, Kilis and Şanlıurfa province. We have been operating community center in Eyyubiye, Hayati Harran district since July of 2015, followed by the establishment another center in Şanlıurfa City in cooperation with local NGO in 2014.
