





WFP continued to support Syrian populations in the country under the PRRO 200987. WFP will support up to 88,200 vulnerable refugees from Syria through general food distribution, nutrition support, vocational trainings, capacity enhancement and access to micro-credit schemes.

June distribution took place from 15 to 20 June 2017, targeting 74,669 beneficiaries (72,169 Syrian refugees and 2,500 Palestinian refugees from Syria). Redemption period for June cycle ends on 28 June 2017. In June 2017, WFP food voucher value remains at 400 EGP, which is now equivalent to US\$ 22 given the current UN exchange rate.

The data analysis for the 2016 Egyptian Vulnerability Assessment for Refugees (EVAR) in collaboration with UNHCR started in mid-March with the report expected to be released by the second half of 2017.
