<b>Agency Updates</b>	<p><b>IRC:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- From the beginning of September, IRC will be supporting Arab Women Organization (AWO) in Zarqa governorate whereas in Ramtha they will partnering with IFH.</li> <li>- IRC will start a new project in the north by providing legal consultations, and legal Awareness, and there will soon be a consultation meeting with ARDD.</li> <li>- A new project will be opened soon in East Amman within Amman municipality as a small component of the Women Protection and Empowerment (WPE) with an integrated livelihood approach.</li> <li>- IRC will take over GBV and Reproductive Health (RH) component from IMC and will start operation in Azraq camp from the beginning of October.</li> </ul> <p><b>UNFPA:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A half-day workshop was conducted to allow SGBV SWG members to highlight gaps in GBV prevention and response activities on 7/08/2017 Jordan. Key findings will be used to strengthen advocacy efforts with donors and governments. The findings will be very relevant in the light of the current JRP process and shrinking operational space for Protection/GBV activities.</li> <li>- The Higher Population Council (HPC) recently launched a new study on Early Marriage .</li> <li>- UN Joint project – UN Women, UNICEF and UN Women (Hemayati) will be operational from September 2017. A total of seven safe spaces in host communities will be supported through this project in partnership with Jordan Women Union (JWU). The project has a specific component on shelters. <b>Jordan Response Plan (JRP) Update</b>	The Social Protection Task Force headed by the Ministry of Social Development (MoSD) is leading the process of the JRP Development for 2018-2019. The sector has already submitted the Sector Vulnerability Assessment (SVA) and Comprehensive Vulnerability Assessment (CVA) with MoPIC. On behalf of SGBV SWG a specific indicator on the women <i>who suffered from violence by current or former husband</i> at the governorate level from the Demographic Health Survey (DHS) 2012 has been added in the list of indicators. MoPIC has not yet shared the Project summary sheets (PSS), as soon as the PSS are received the members will be requested (by the Protection Working Group) to share information about their projected projects, targets and budgets for 2018 and 2019.
