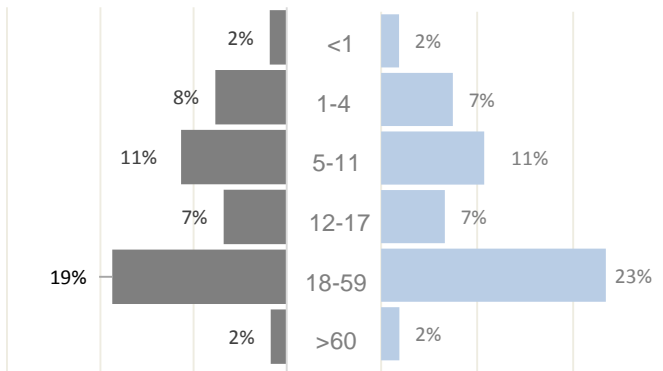

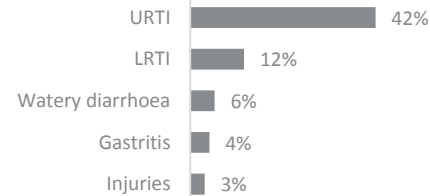

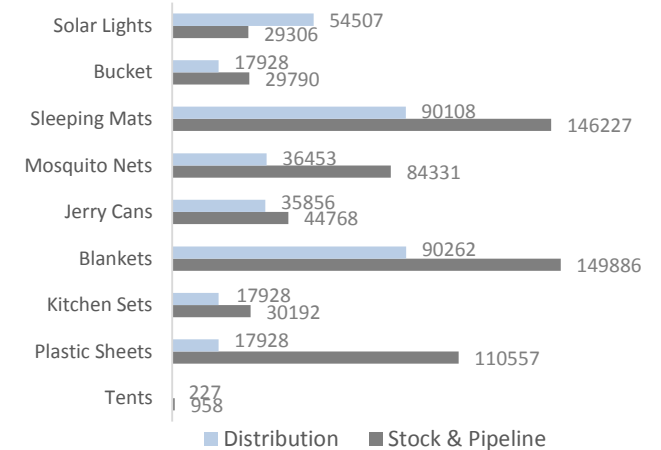
Refugees received medical attention & counselling.

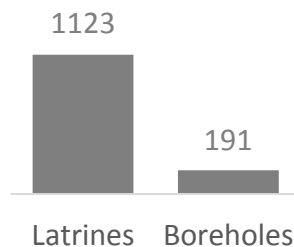

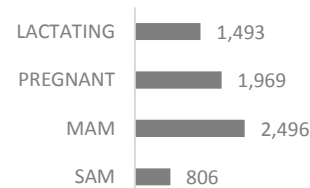
