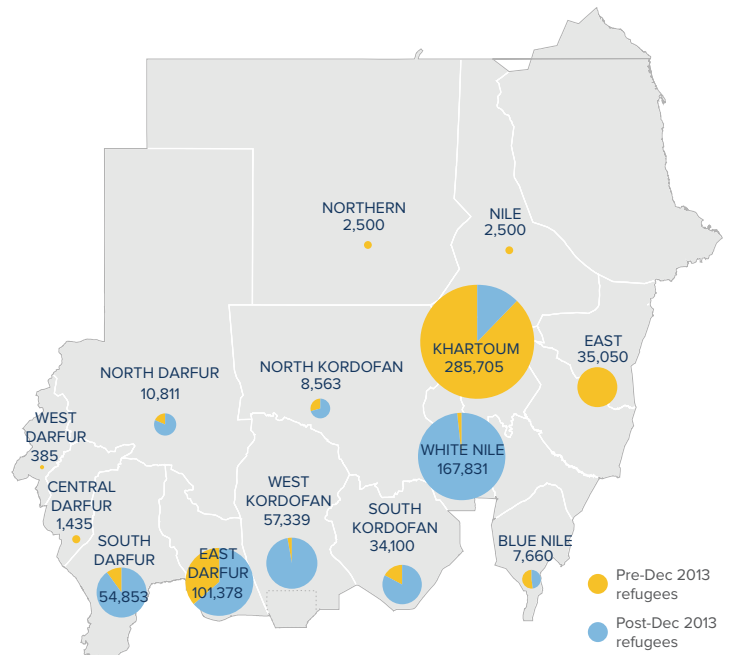
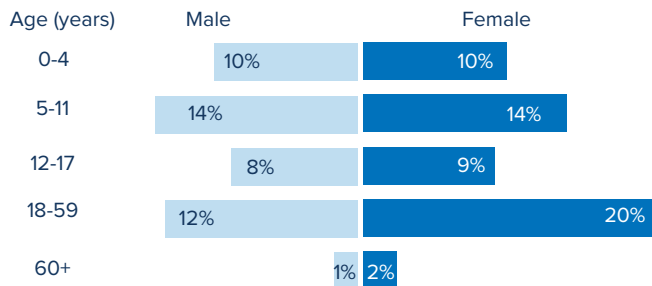

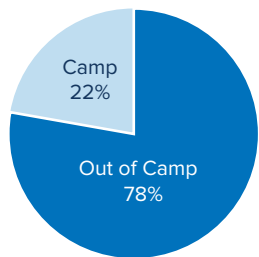
POPULATION BY STATE



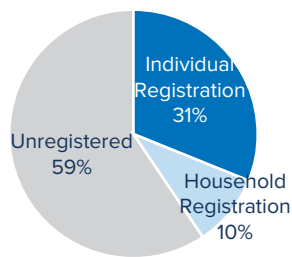
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN



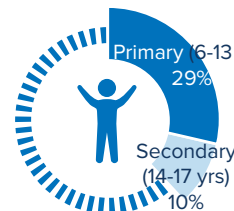
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION



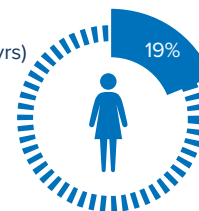

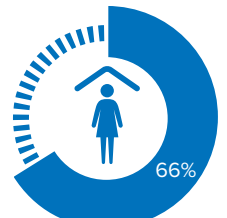
SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)



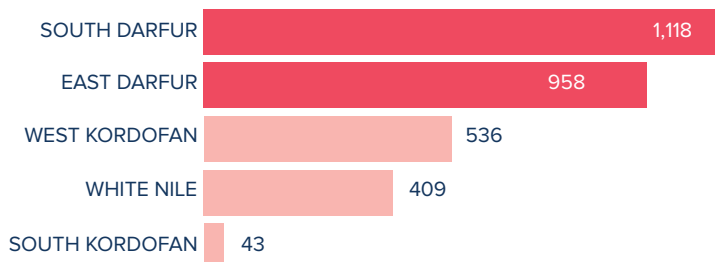
REPRODUCTIVE-AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)



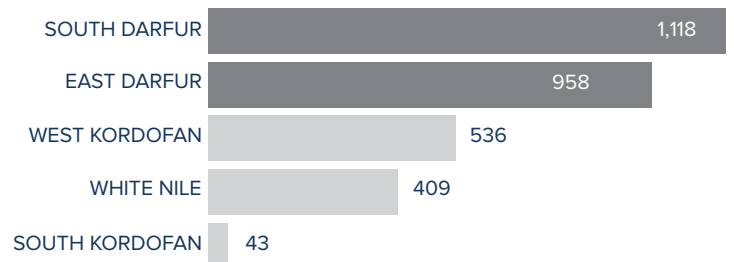
WOMEN-HEADED HOUSEHOLDS



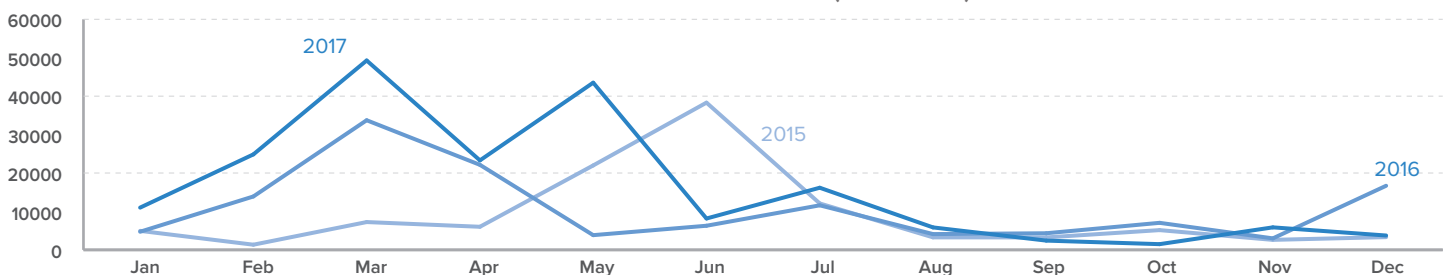
