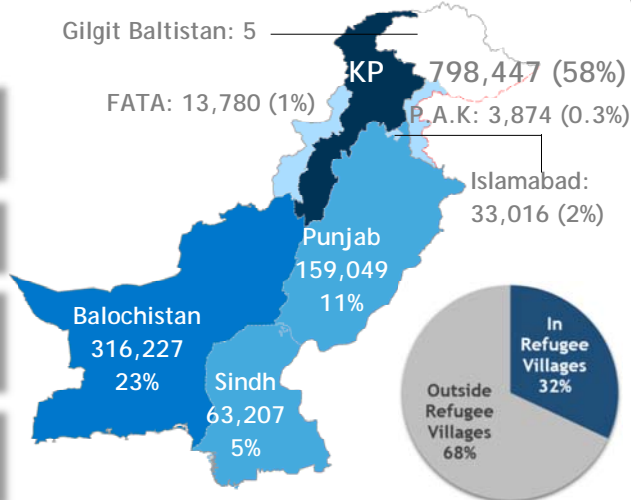

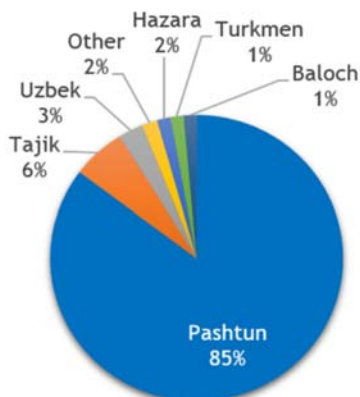

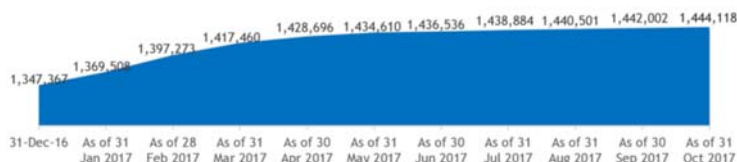

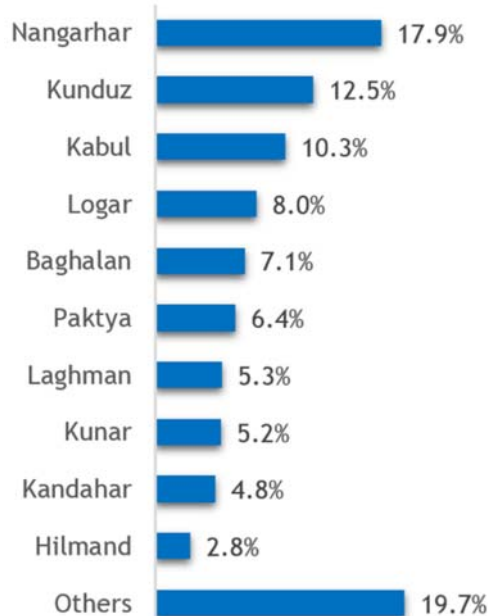
Breakdown by Ethnicity

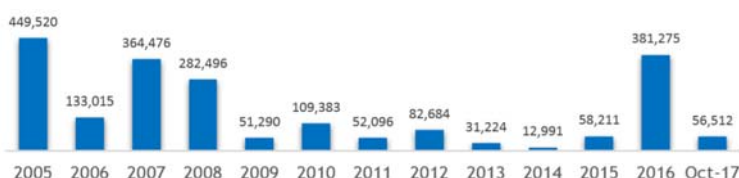

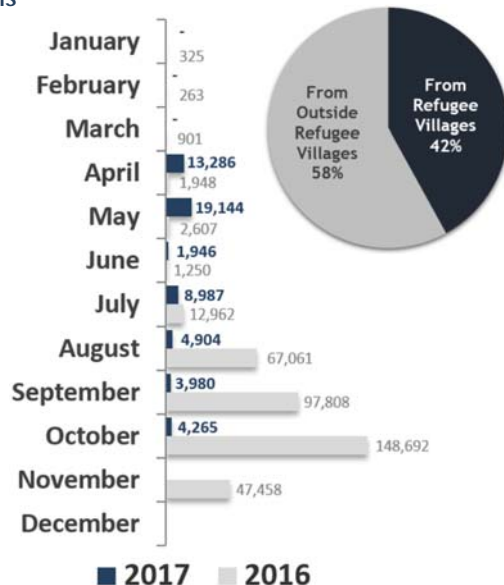

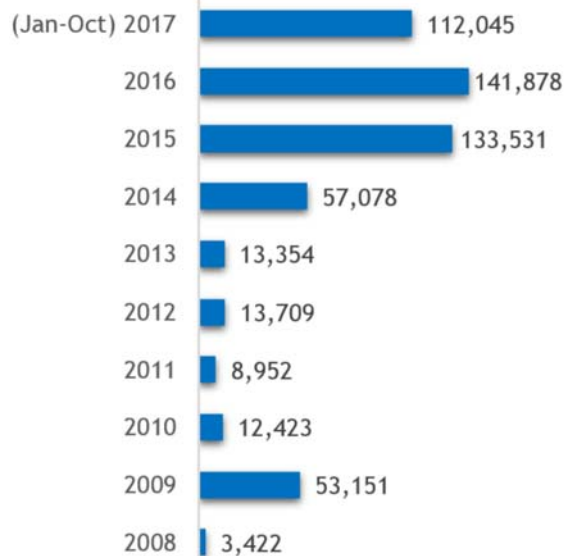

In 2017, UNHCR prioritized funds for the registration of 60,000 children, the target has been increased to 120,000 as the initial target was completed as of the end of April. The target for the issuance of birth certificates is 90,000 birth certificates. The target for the issuance of individual PoR cards is 150,000 children who have reached five years of age and are eligible to receive their individual cards from the PCM centres.

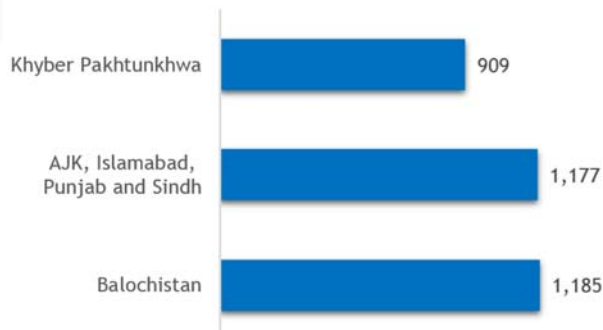

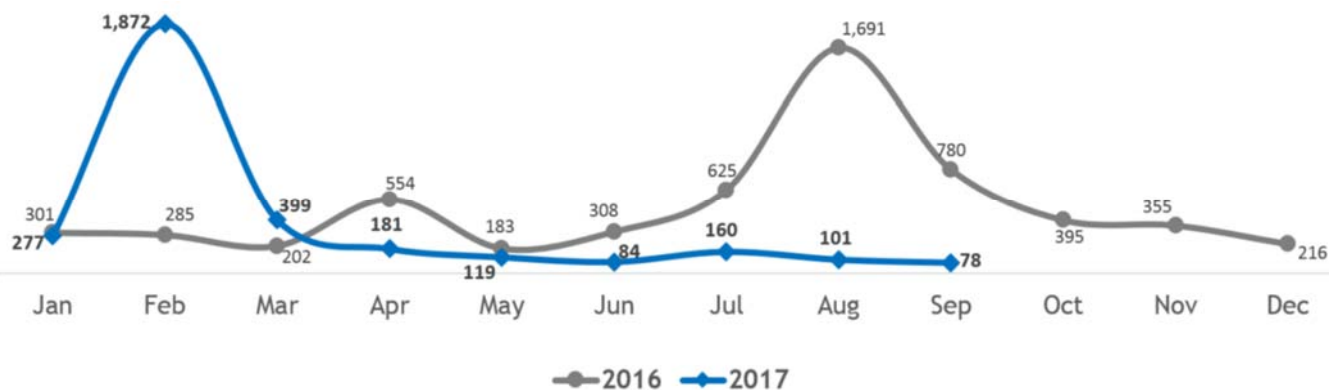
