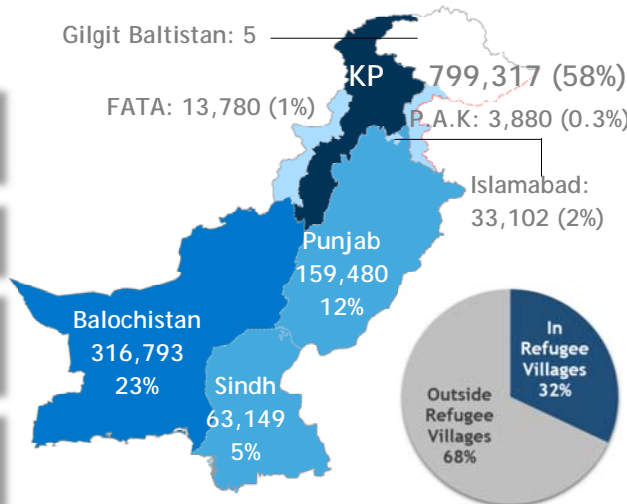

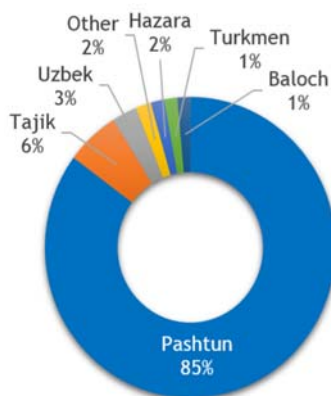

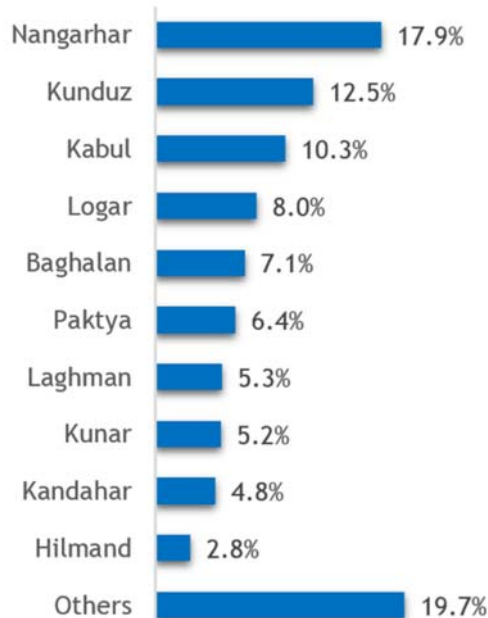

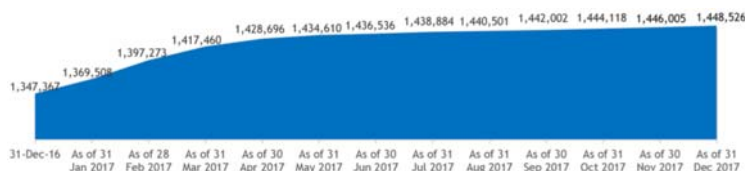
Breakdown by Ethnicity

Remaining 1,594 received UNHCR's cash assistance in the past. Voluntary repatriation program has been suspended from 30 November 2017 to 31 March 2018 due to winter break

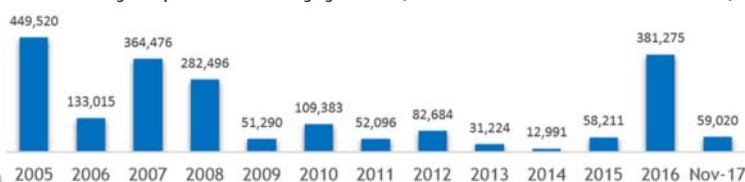

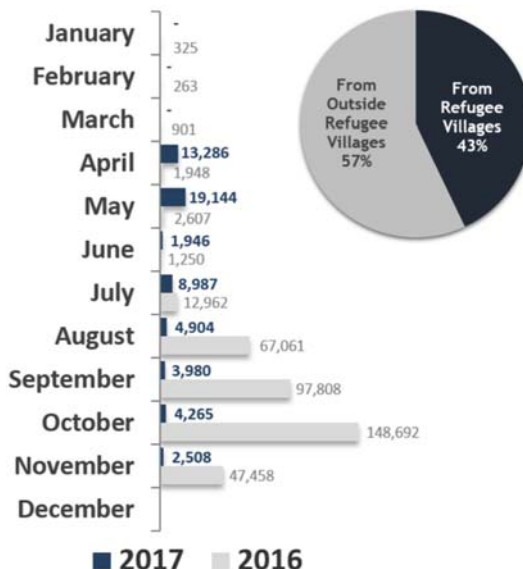

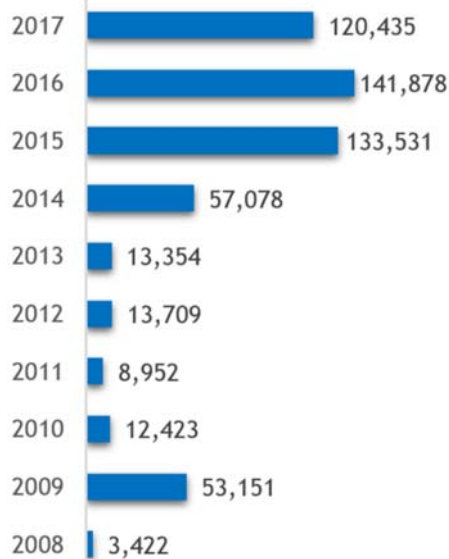

In 2017, UNHCR prioritized funds for the registration of 60,000 children, the target was increased to 120,000 as the initial target was completed as of the end of April. The target for the issuance of birth certificates was 90,000 birth certificates. The target for the issuance of individual PoR cards was 150,000 children who have reached five years of age and are eligible to receive their individual cards from the PCM centres.

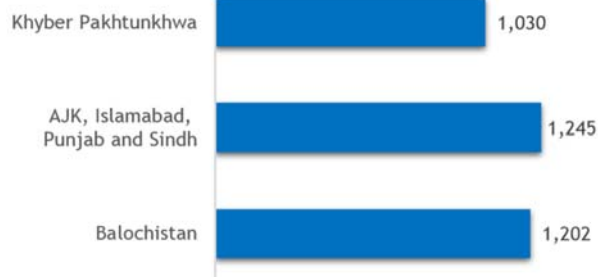

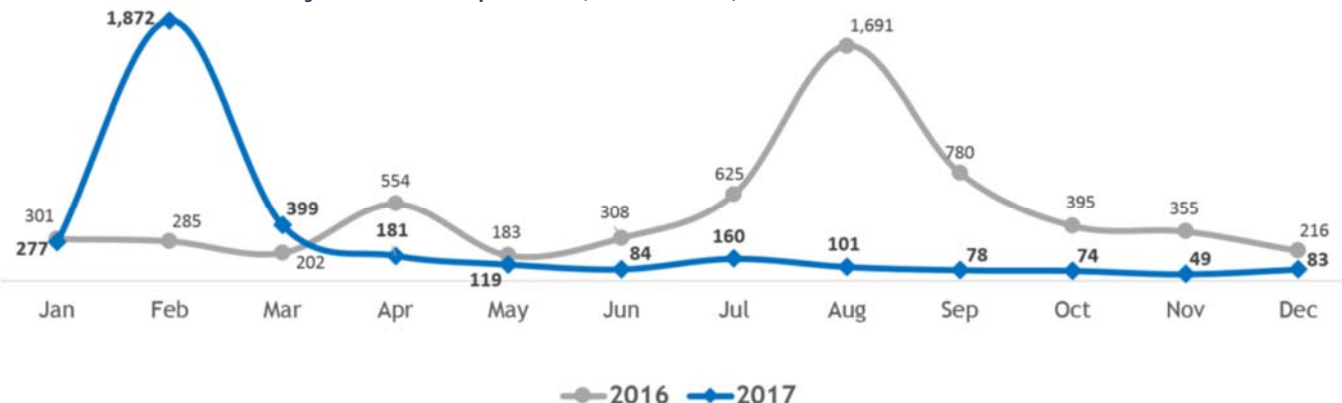
