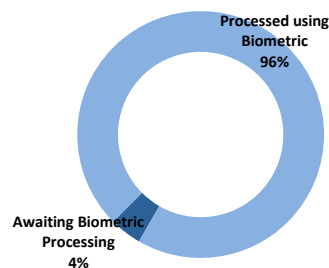

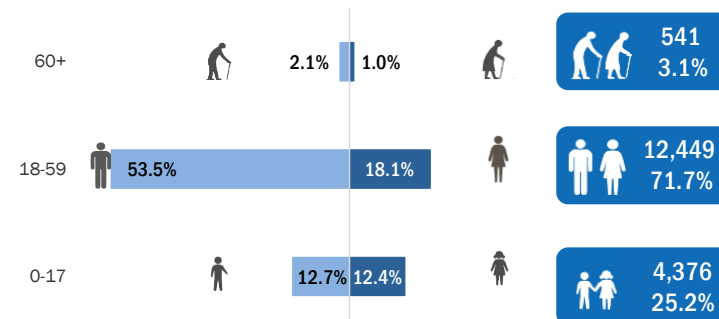

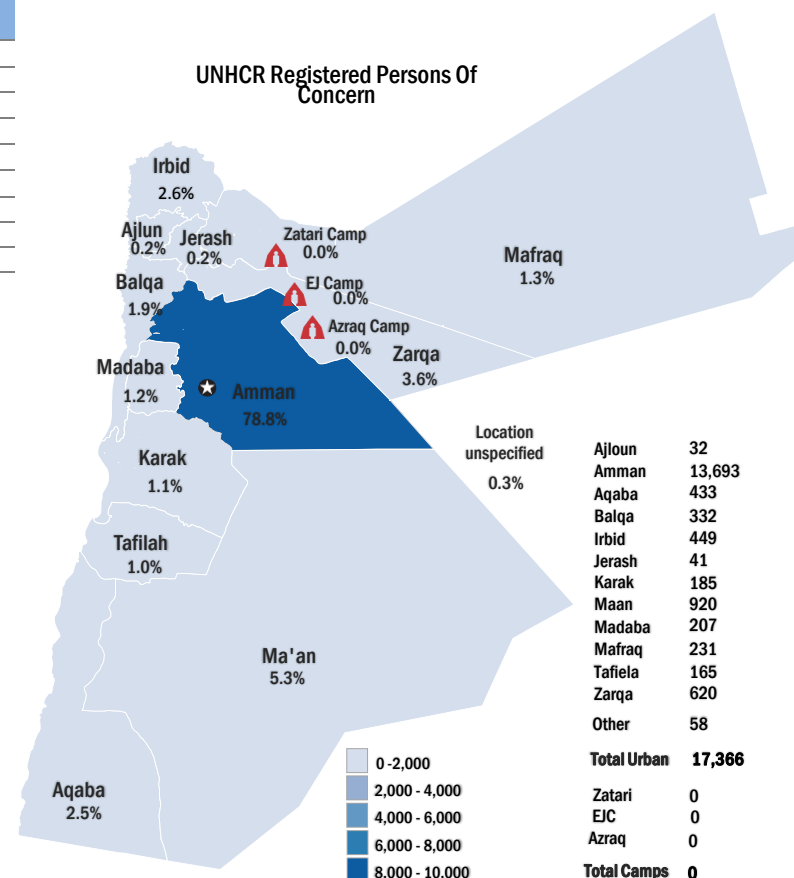
Biometric Statistics (IRIS)



Age-Gender Breakdown

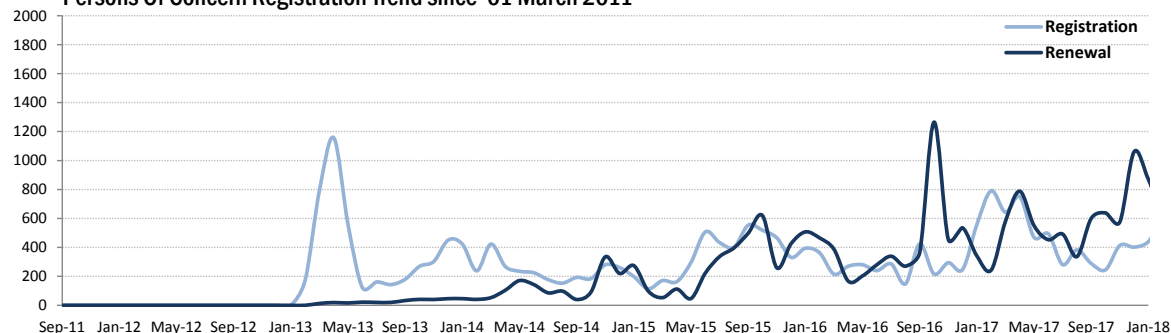


UNHCR Registered Persons Of Concern
