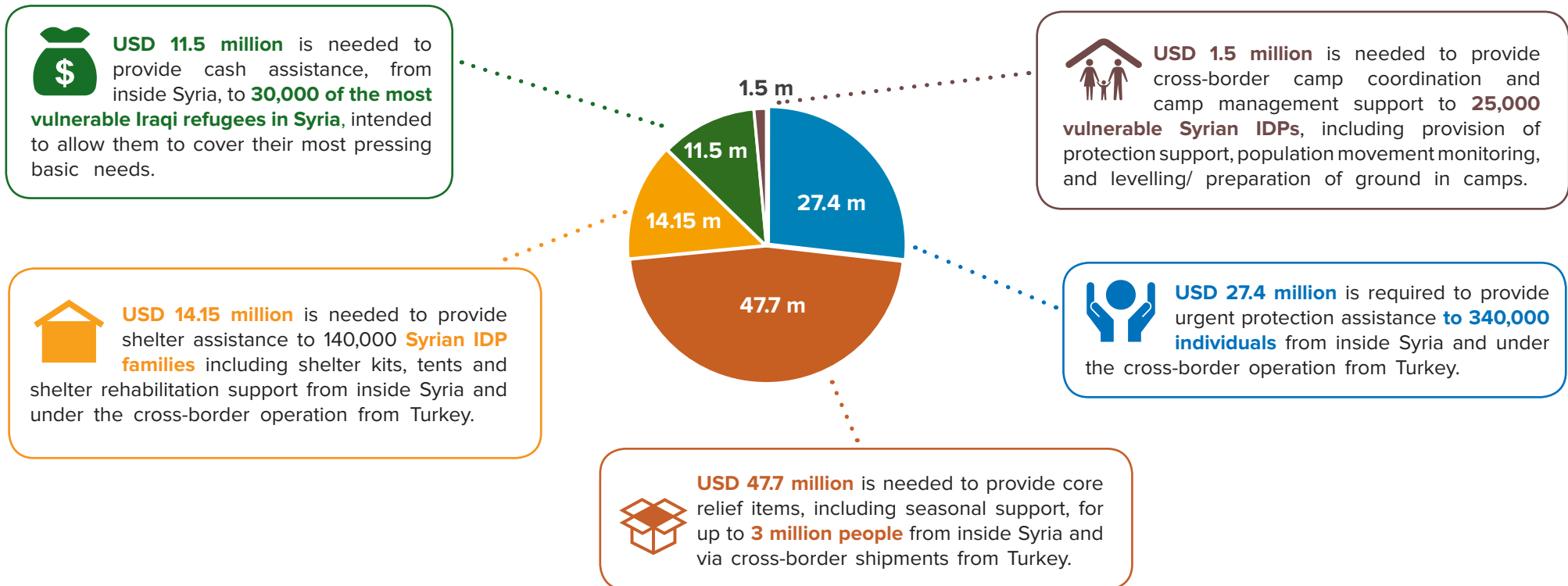


USD 102 MILLION URGENTLY NEEDED TO SUPPORT MILLIONS OF IDPs AND IRAQI REFUGEES IN SYRIA

UNHCR has rapidly scaled-up its response inside Syria as a result of the latest developments which have displaced tens of thousands of people, particularly in Afrin, eastern Ghouta and Idlib. As the number of people in need of humanitarian support continues to grow, UNHCR is urgently appealing for USD 102 million to maintain and expand critical and life-saving programmes for the emergency response in these areas.

Urgent Requirements: USD 102 MILLION



UNHCR's 2018 financial requirements for protection and assistance for the Syria situation amount to USD 1.95 billion. As of 17 April 2018, only USD 211 million has been received, leaving a USD 1.74 billion gap. Quick disbursement of existing pledges and commitments, as well as additional funding, is greatly appreciated.
