

AFGHAN ASSISTED RETURN WEEKLY UPDATE 30 June 2018

During last week (24 June – 30 June 2018), **533** Afghan refugees returned to Afghanistan (512 from Pakistan, 20 from Iran and 1 individuals from other countries)

7,951 Afghan refugees returned to Afghanistan in 2018, out of which 7,275 from Pakistan, 577 from Iran and 99 from other countries (as of 30 June 2018) This is **76%** less compared to the same period in 2017, when










ASSISTED RETURN BY ASSISTED RETURN BY COUNTRY OF ASYLUM ENCASHMENT CENTERS
