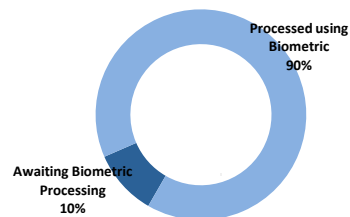

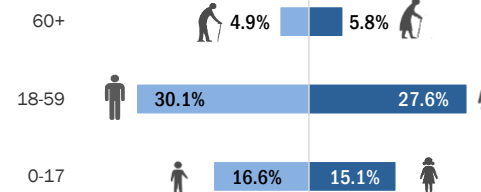

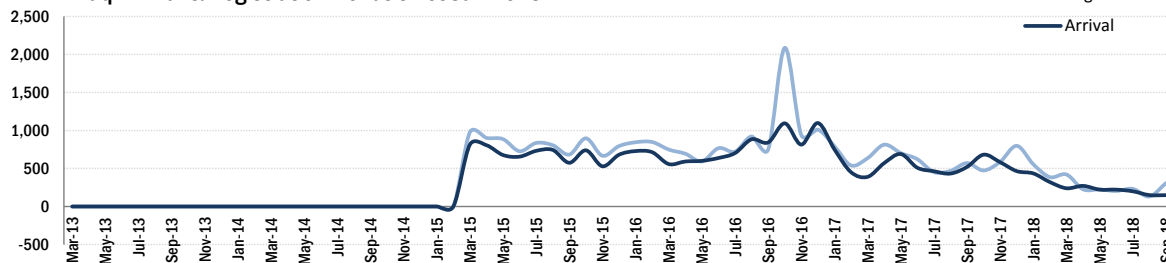

Age-Gender Breakdown

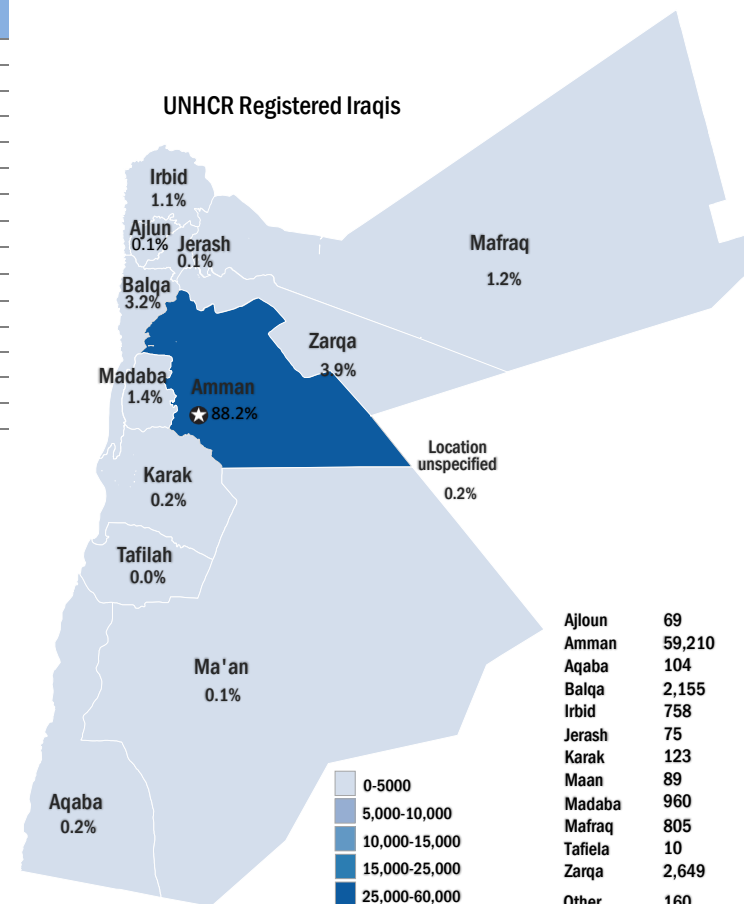
