

MIGRATION ROUTE




36 % had moved internally before leaving Venezuela

Among migrants, **14.5%** have stayed in another city before arriving in Lima.



50% of the surveyed stayed in the cities of Quito (29%) or Bogotá (21%).

REASON TO LEAVE THE CURRENT CITY




