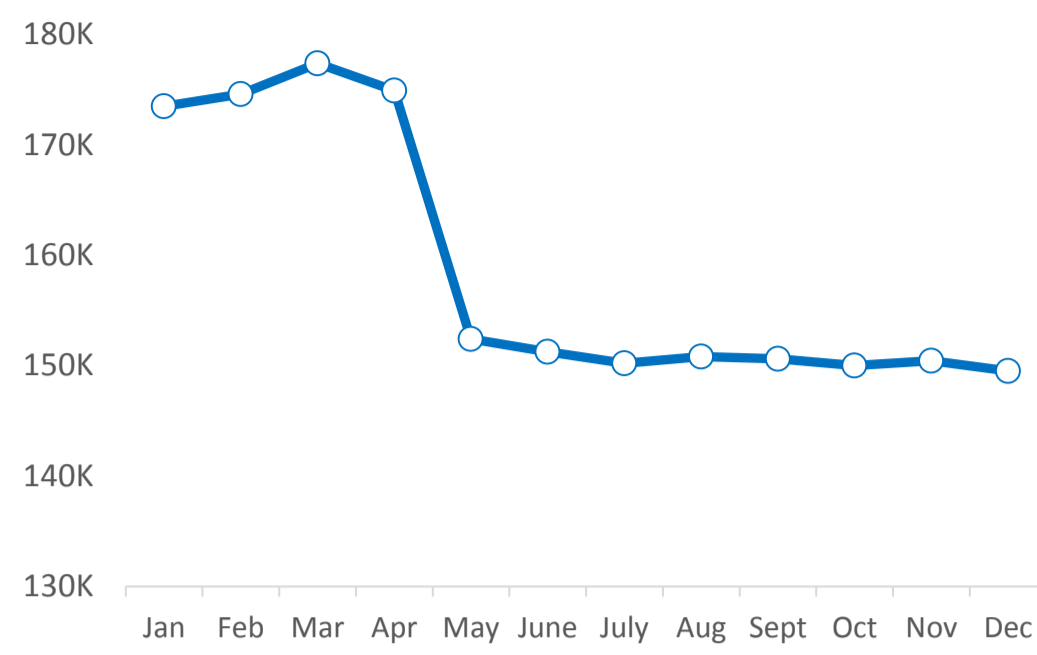

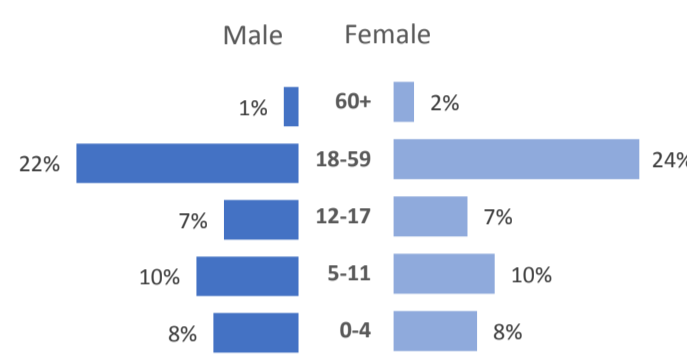

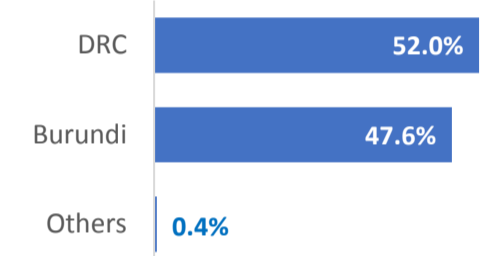

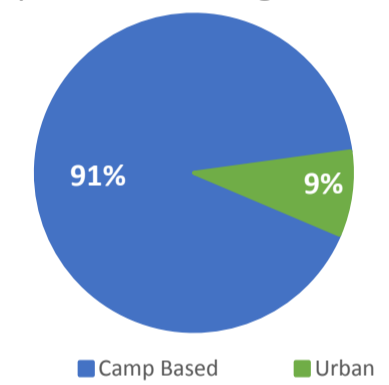

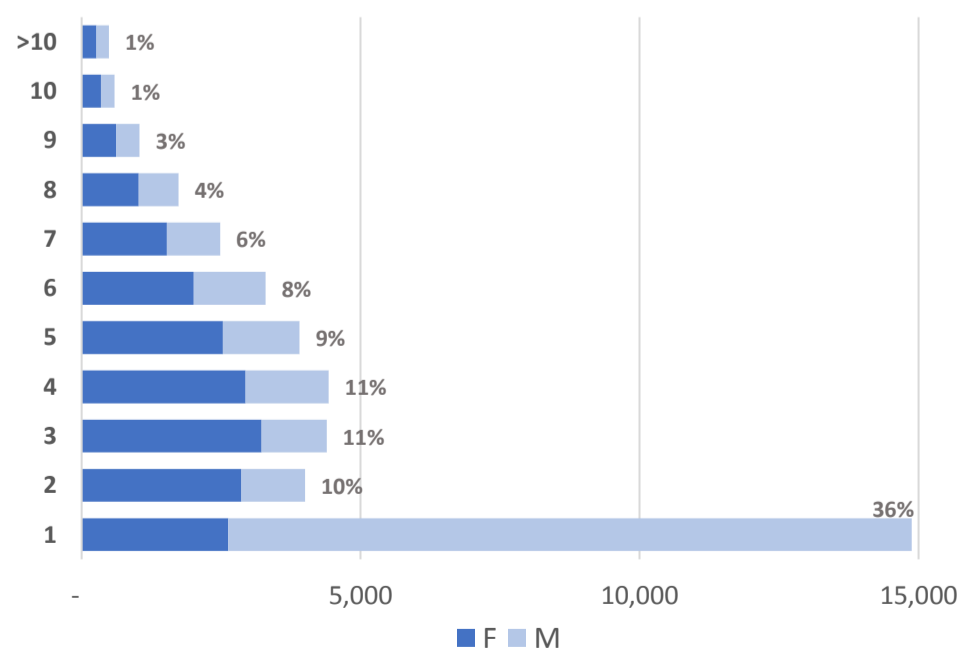

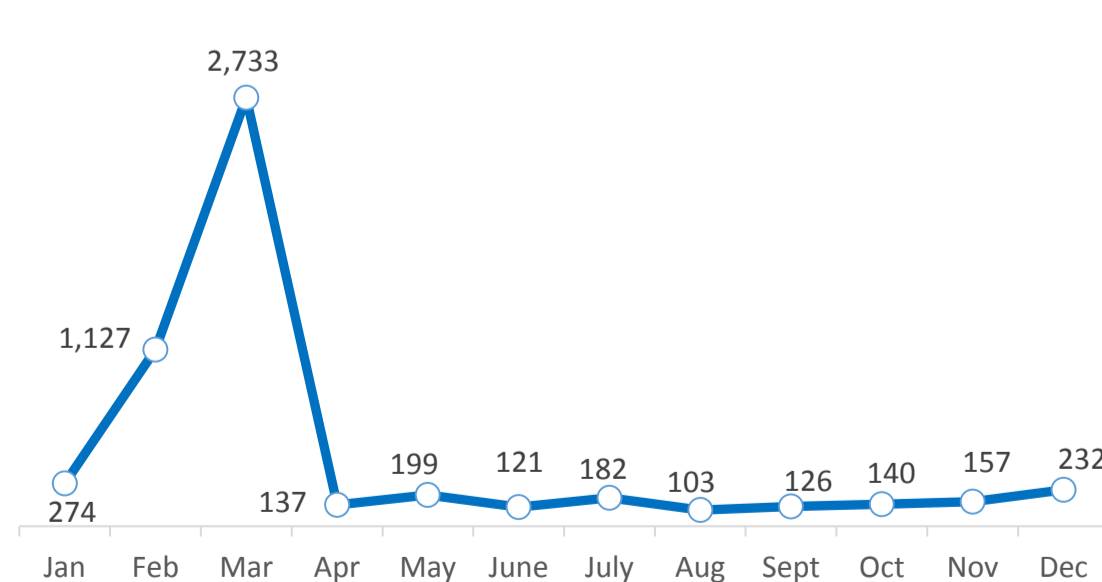

Family Size Breakdown



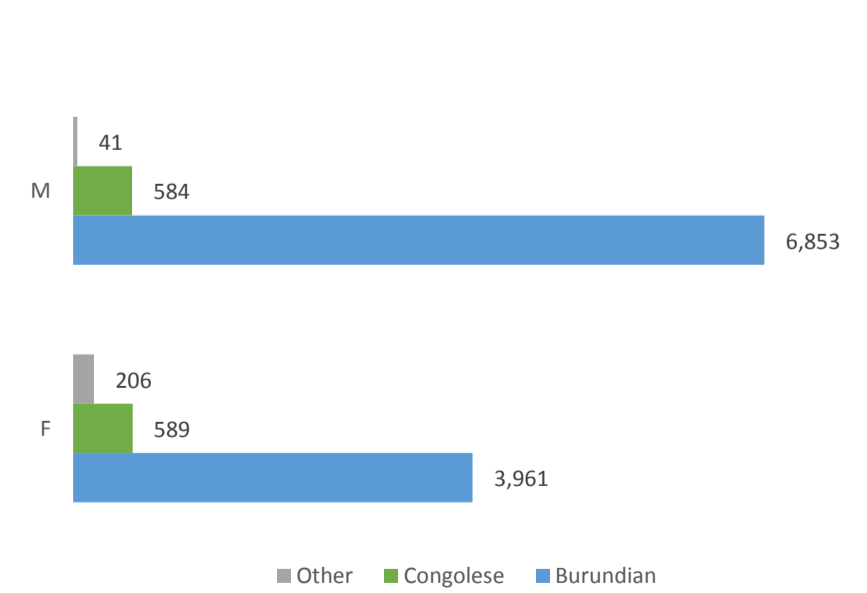
%age represents proportion of family sizes to the total number of households
