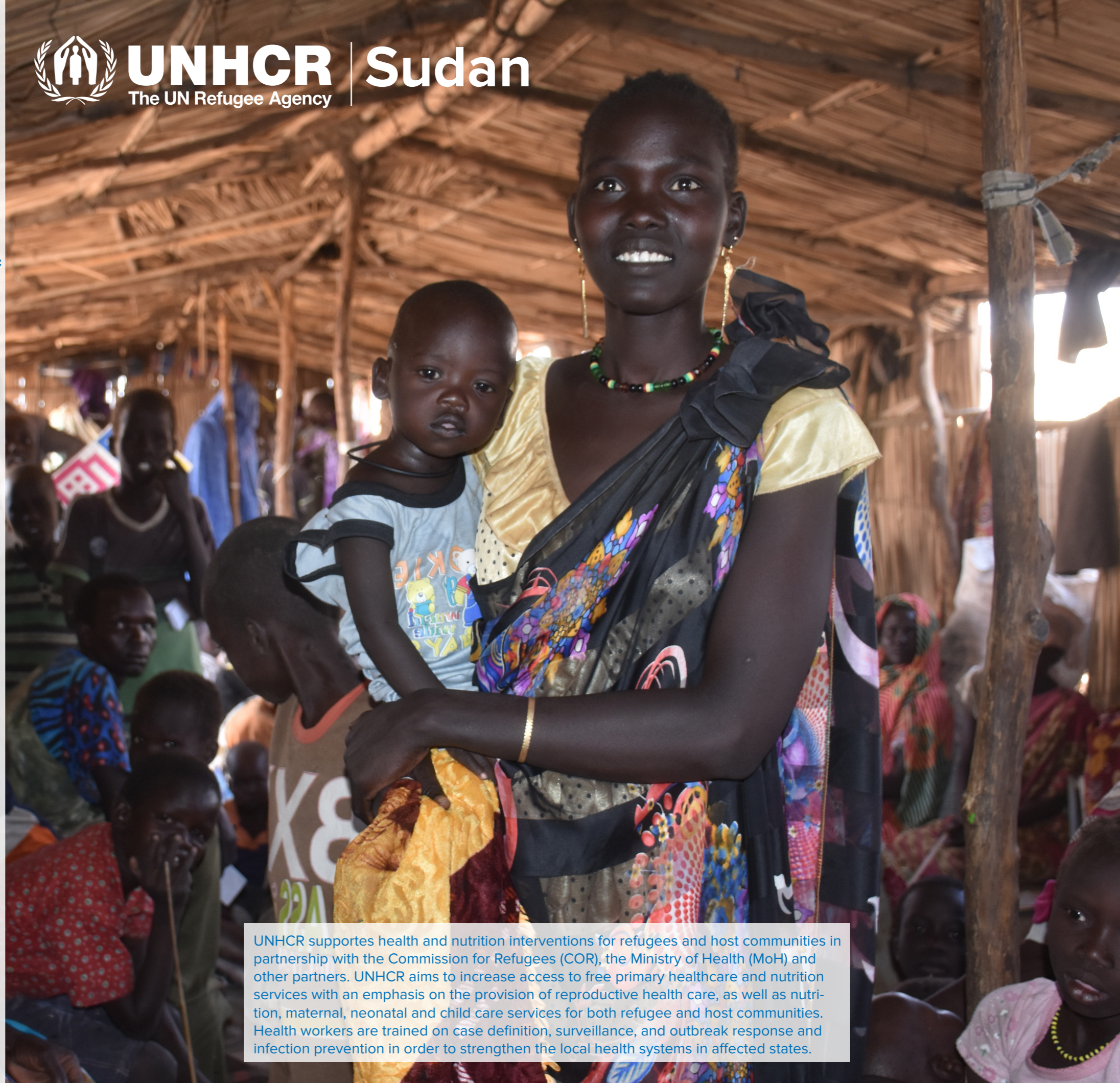

UNHCR supports health and nutrition interventions for refugees and host communities in partnership with the Commission for Refugees (COR), the Ministry of Health (MoH) and other partners. UNHCR aims to increase access to free primary healthcare and nutrition services with an emphasis on the provision of reproductive health care, as well as nutrition, maternal, neonatal and child care services for both refugee and host communities. Health workers are trained on case definition, surveillance, and outbreak response and infection prevention in order to strengthen the local health systems in affected states.
