Areas of intervention and key activities





Area of intervention 1: Direct emergency assistance

- Education in emergencies =
- Provision of Non-Food Items (clothes, cooking kits, etc.)
- Provision of adequate and safe accomodation in shelters or with host families
- Provision of primary and specialised medical attention
- Provision of humanitarian transport
- Access to food and nutrition
- Distribution of hygiene kits and adequate water and sanitation infraestructure
- Cash assistance

Area of intervention 3: Socio-economic and cultural inclusion

Promotion of effective access to basic services, including health, education, public services, and housing



Support access to the labor market, including validation of qualifications and employability training with support of the public and private sectors

Promotion of social cohesion and peaceful coexistence between different communities

Area of intervention 2: Protection response

Protection monitoring (→) Legal assistance and legal advice Information campaigns on access to services for Colombian returnees **R** Support to regularize status and documentation • Attention to people with specific needs (children, elderly, indigenous, victims of trafficking, women with particular needs, etc.) Strenghtening of community organizations and networks

Area of intervention 4: Strengthening capacity of host government



• Strengthening national and local institutions, through technical assistance and increasing the operational capacity for the response to the refugee, migrant and returnee population
