20 requests pending since September for enrolments to primary school education. Same problem as ADDMA in finding apartments.	
Solidarity Now:	
Ongoing activities in Thiva camp. Close collaboration with teachers in Thiva's formal schools. The new REC has formed a WhatsApp group and follows-up daily with the activities for homework support. ZEP classes in secondary education have not started yet in Thiva – they were about to start in the beginning of November – for the DYEP classes English and math teachers are not yet assigned. In this way children lose their motivation in following the school.
