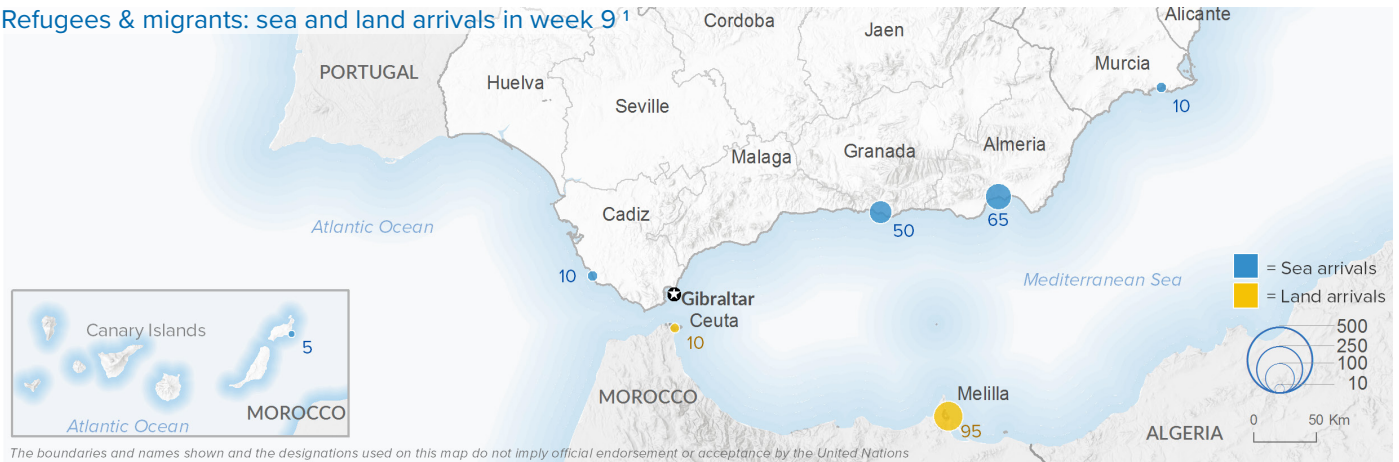


# SPAIN Weekly snapshot - Week 9 (25 Feb - 3 Mar 2019)

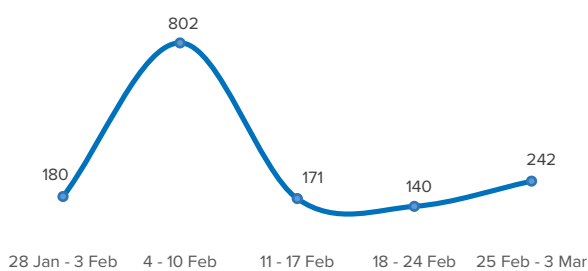

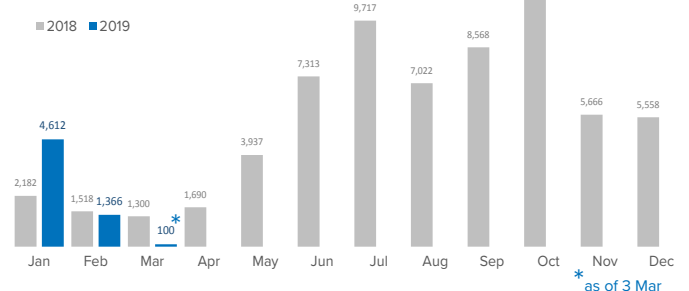

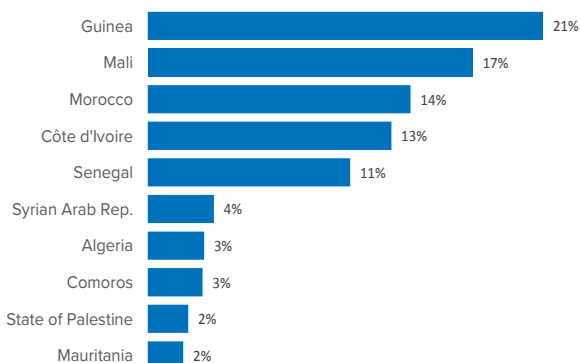
## Sea and land arrivals during the last five weeks<sup>1</sup>
