1. BEAT GLOBAL Update

BEAT started their programme on Monday and will be running events in Zaatari all week with a final show on Friday the 21st. BEAT Global is looking to meet with members from the Youth Task Force on Thursday to gather feedback and discuss possible ways forward. BEAT will be sharing a survey with youth and the community to gather feedback on the week visit.

2. WCUK and Young Syrian Girl on upcoming global conference.

16-year-old, Taima'a Hariri, who was selected to represent children and youth at the UN Day of General Discussion in Geneva at the end of September joined the group for the meeting and shared her experience and involvement with youth groups in the camps and the message of her upcoming speech in Geneva. The focus of her speech will be on the rights of children, she will be sharing the experience of children in the camp, and discussing ways to empower children and young people in addressing challenges they face such as child labour and access to education.

3. Going through final sections of FGD report

The group went through the remaining sections of the final report from the FDGS. Kareem from UNICEF had prepared additional questions to be added to the document, and the document was shared with the group. The thematic areas, participation, youth engagement, Education, protection, and livelihood, were discussed and the group suggested edits.

Action Points:

- Leana will be presenting the report's findings with the CMC later today.

- Recommendation to suggest to Basic Needs to ask all their members to start sharing all livelihood announcements on the same day each week.

4. AOBs

1. UNICEF is to start a training on youth entrepreneurship, a human centered design, the training will take place in Zaatari and will target young people aged 18 to 24. Training will be held in one of the Makani centers. Details on location and timing is TBD. UNICEF and One Foundation are looking for youth who are motivated and have a good understanding of social problems within their communities.
