\square	Persons of concern's documentation strengthened	 Ensure access to civil documentation, legal documentation and counseling; Civil Status Department and Shari'a courts to document incidents of marriage, birth, divorce, custody, family disputes, etc; Assess trafficking and statelessness cases, provide all legal assistance and advocate to rectify their situation when possible; Support the provision of the Ministry of Interior Service Card.
	Access to legal assistance & legal remedies improved	 Provide legal counseling in UNHCR registration centres and helpdesks; Facilitation/advocacy for the rectification of the legal status of persons of concern; Conduct regular, high-level meetings for advocacy with, inter alia, the Syrian Refugee Affairs Directorate, Ministry of Interior, Residence and Border Department, Public Security Directorate and Ministry of Labour; Liaise with the Government of Jordan on legal aspects of access to employment.
沐 →	Access to the territory improved & risk of refoulement reduces, risks related to detention reduced & freedom of movement increased	 Follow up and secure the preservation of international protection of persons of concern detained through official correspondence and verbal intervention; Conduct advocacy for the rectification of the legal status of persons of concern with complex/delicate issues; Facilitate the access for Refugee Status Determination, Resettlement and other units to conduct interviews in cases where the persons of concern are still in detention; Conduct regular monitoring of detention facilities across Jordan through official visits to the facilities and interviews with detainees.
	Capacity building related to refugee protection	- Capacity building on UNHCR mandate and refugee law for the Government officials, as well as for non-governmental organiza- tions, judicial entities, academics and UNHCR staff in order to have a forum for discussion and advocacy.
	Protection counseling & referral improved	- Conduct protection inteviews at Help Desks across the country to provide protection advice and refer cases for assistance.
