

Sea Arrivals Dashboard

Overview

So far in 2019, a total of 7,097 refugees and migrants arrived in Greece by sea. The majority are from Afghanistan (40%), Syria (13%) and Iraq (13%). More than half of the population are women (23%) and children (38%), while 39% are men.


Arrivals in April 2019, at 1,856 decreased in comparison to March, when 1,904 people had arrived on the islands. Arrivals during 2019 are 15% lower than those in 2018.


Lesvos received the majority (39%) of all new arrivals, during the first three months of 2019, followed by the Dodecanese islands (28%), Samos (22%) and Chios (11%).

7,097 sea arrivals January - April 2019¹


Arrivals from 2015 to 2019





Demographics


Similar to last year, over one-third of arrivals in 2019 are children. Of those, nearly 7 out of 10 are below the age of 12. Additionally, 15% of all children were registered upon arrival as unaccompanied or separated, mainly from Afghanistan, Syria and Iraq. Some 33% of arrivals are men between 18 and 39 years old. Only 4% of arrivals are 50 years old or older.






Demographics (continued)

The majority of new arrivals in 2019 are from Afghanistan (2,814), Syria (956) and Iraq (930). Similar to last year, the majority of arrivals from Afghanistan, Syria and Iraq arrived in family groups.



Entry points

During 2019, the majority of refugees and migrants in Greece arrived on Lesvos (2,785), the Dodecanese islands (1,969) and Samos (1,547). In April, refugees and migrants arrived on seven islands. Lesvos received the highest number of people from Afghanistan comparing to the overall number of sea arrivals in Greece in 2019, whilst the Dodecanese islands received the majority of people originating from the State of Palestine.
