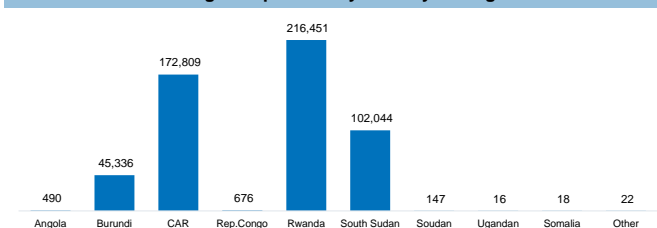

(*)The figure of 45,336 of Burundian Refugees includes 42,090 new caseload and 3,246 old caseload. (**)
As of Jun 30, 2019, the number of Central African refugees in the DRC has slightly increased from 172,768 to 172,809. The increase is due to births in the Bili camp as well as regularization cases observed after 2018 Verification exercises in the provinces of North Ubangi, South Ubangi and Kinshasa.
(***)The figure of 216,451 Rwandan refugees is the result of the registration done by the DRC Government in 2013-2014. During the Biometric verification exercise of Rwandan Refugees jointly conducted by CNR and UNHCR in 2015-2016 and 2018, a total of 76,091 individuals were biometrically enrolled.
(***)The figure of 102,044 south Sudanese includes the new caseload 100,264 and 1,780 old caseload. Out of the new caseload, 27,922 are pre-registered.

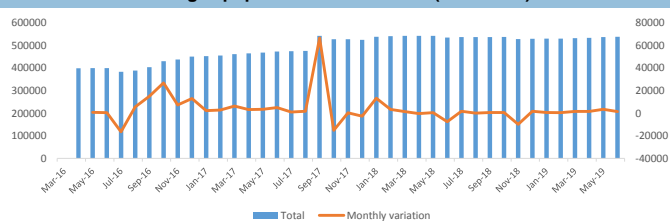
