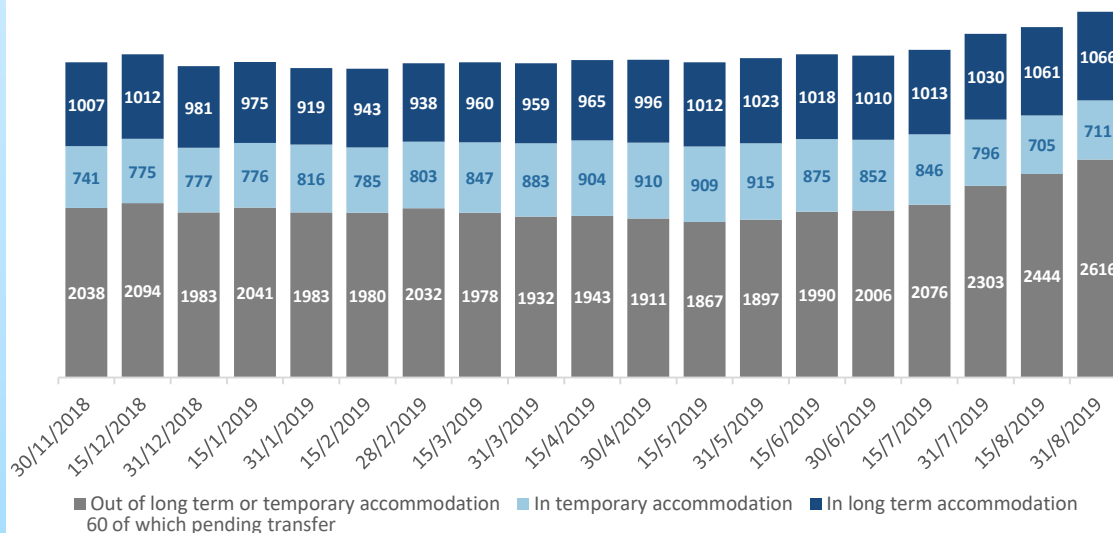

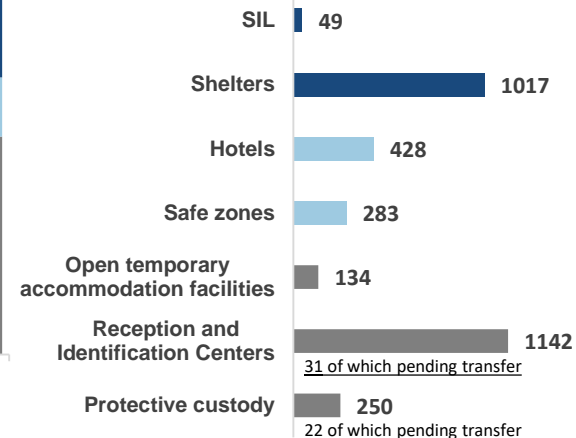
Number of UAC per accommodation type

30 November 2018 – 31 August 2019



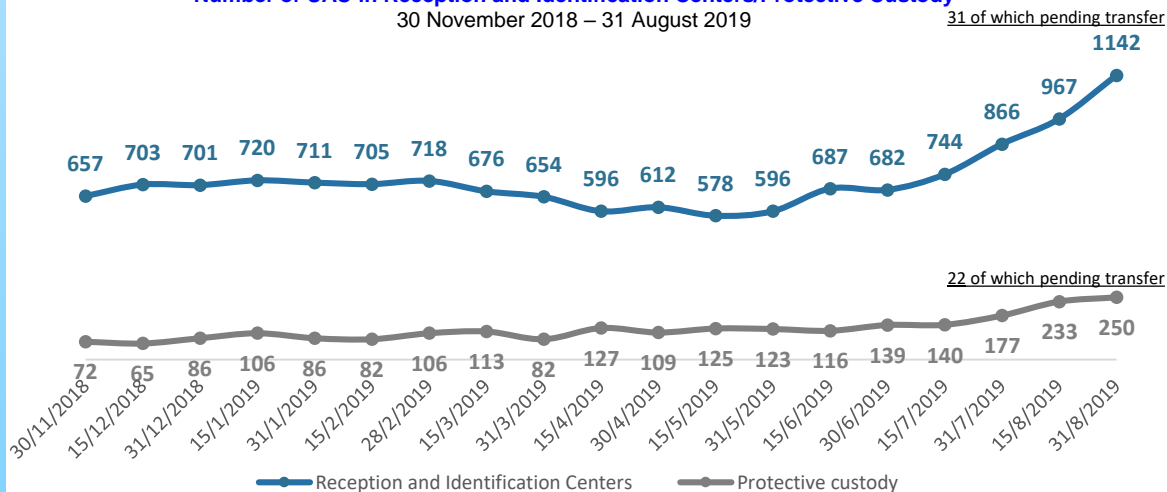

Additionally, **1090** UAC (7 of which pending transfer) have been reported as living in informal/insecure housing conditions such as living temporarily in apartments with others, living in squats, being homeless and moving frequently between different types of accommodation. The above number includes 94 UAC with no location reported by the referral agent. EKKKA is in the process of updating this information.

- **Current:** 47 UAC shelters with total **1,117** places
- **Planned:** 2 UAC shelters with total **80** places

- **Current:** 14 SIL apartments for UAC older than 16 years old with total **56** places

Safe zones*

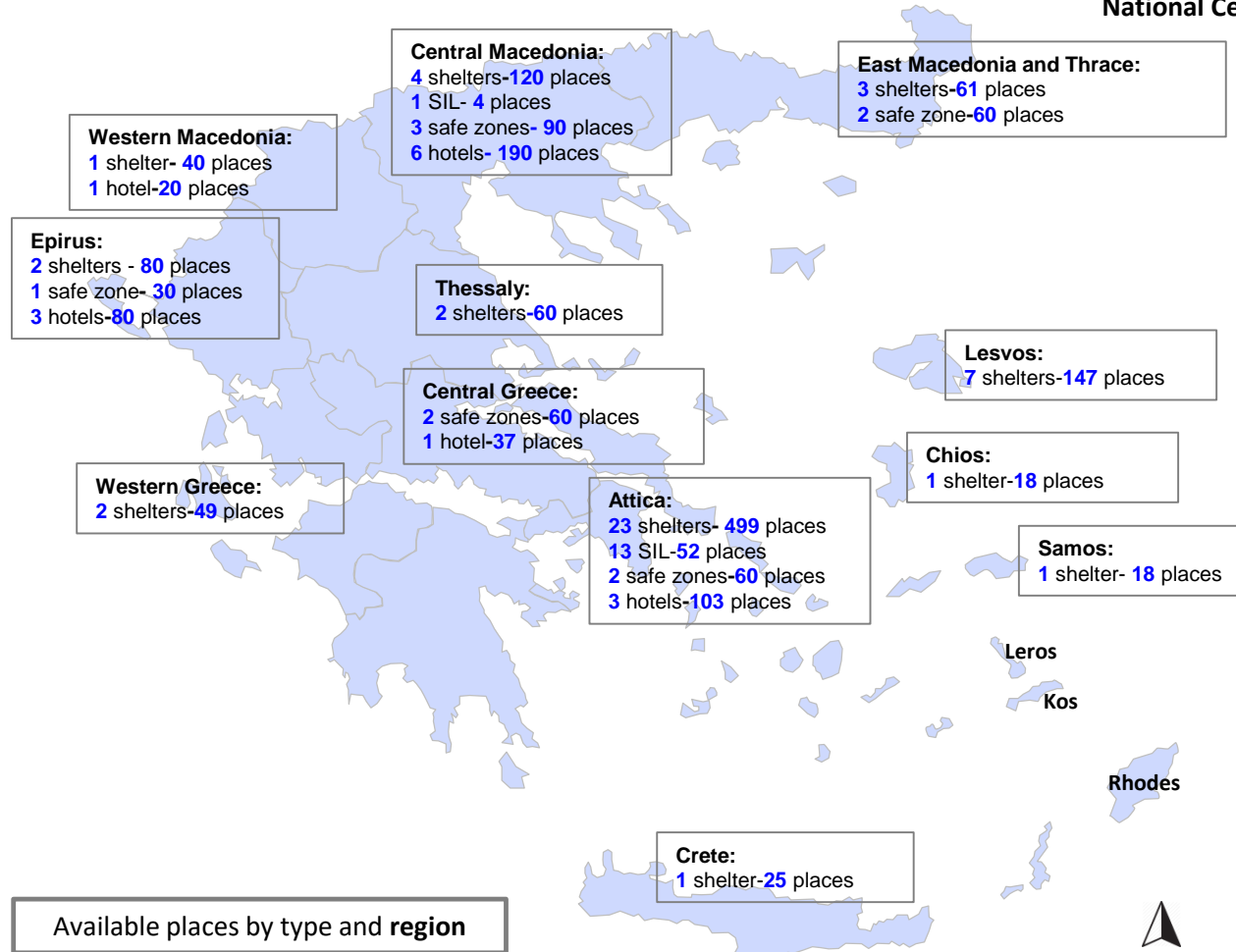
- **Current:** 10 Safe Zones for UAC with total **300** places

Hotels**

- **Current:** 14 Hotels for UAC with total **430** places

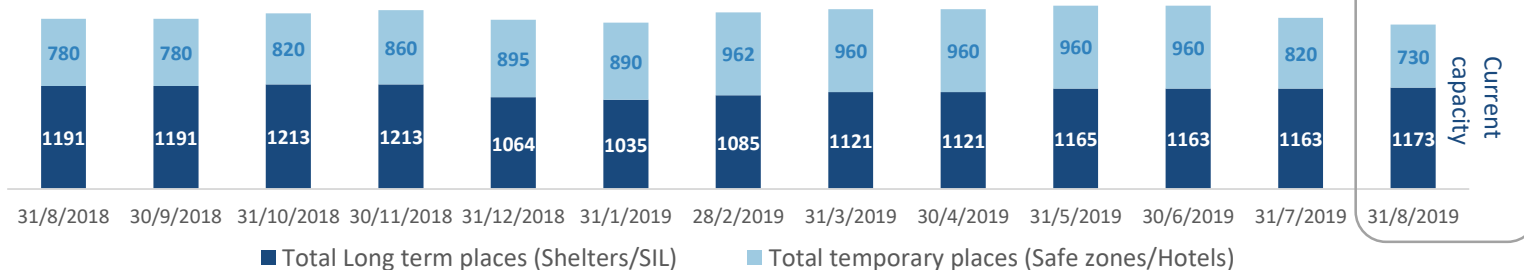
* **Safe Zones** are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their best interests.

** **Hotels** are emergency accommodation spaces being used as a measure to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Priority is given to UAC in Reception and Identification Centers.

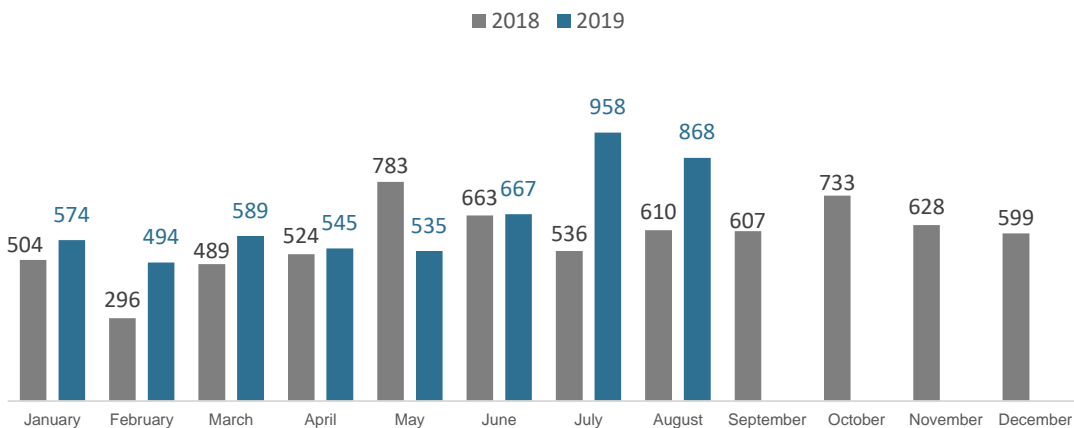

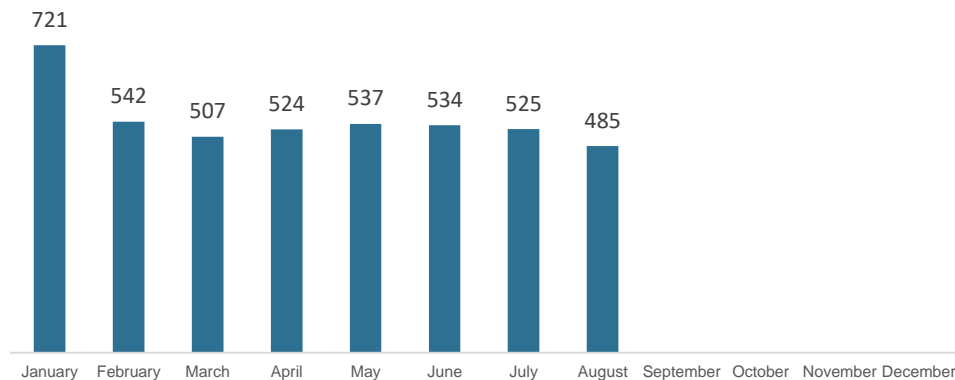

(updated on a monthly basis)



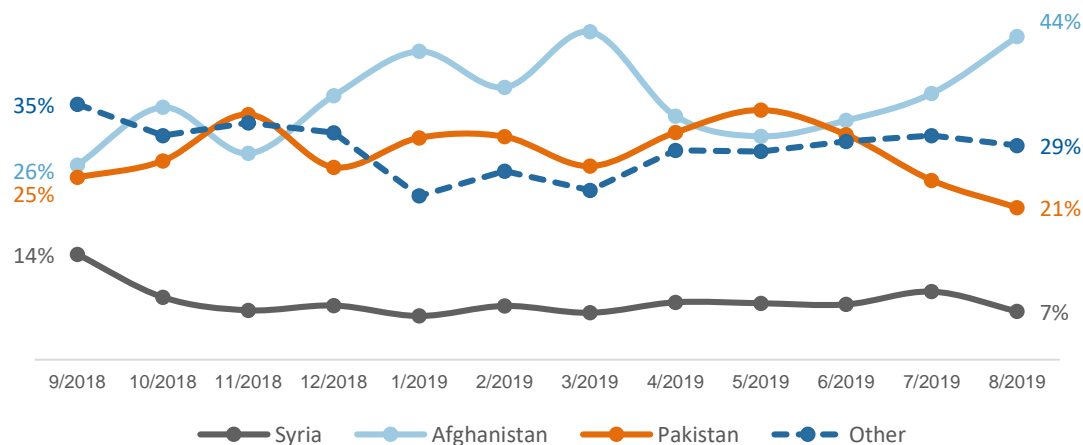
Referrals processed* per month in 2019
(updated on a monthly basis)



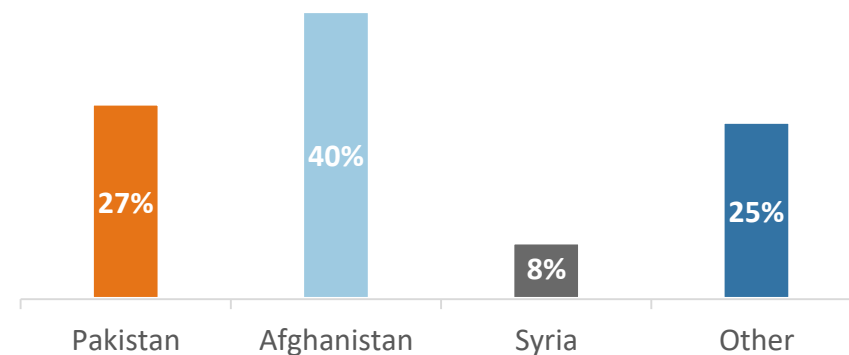
