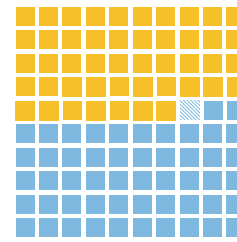
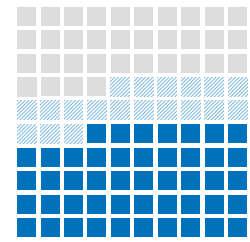

POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

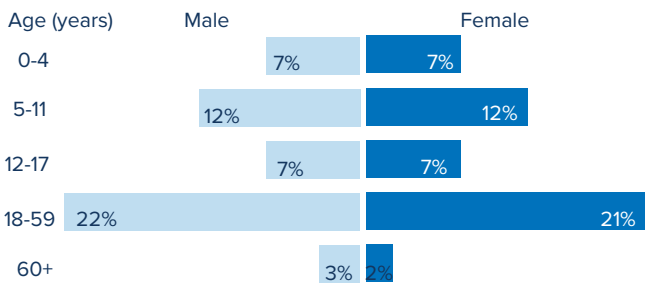

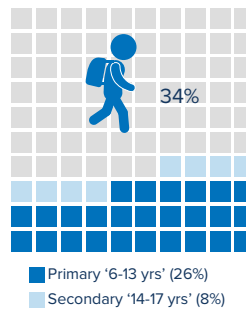

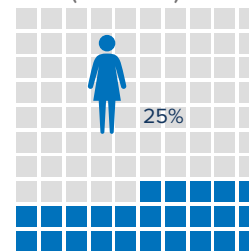
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN **



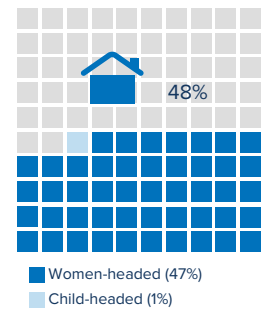
SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) **



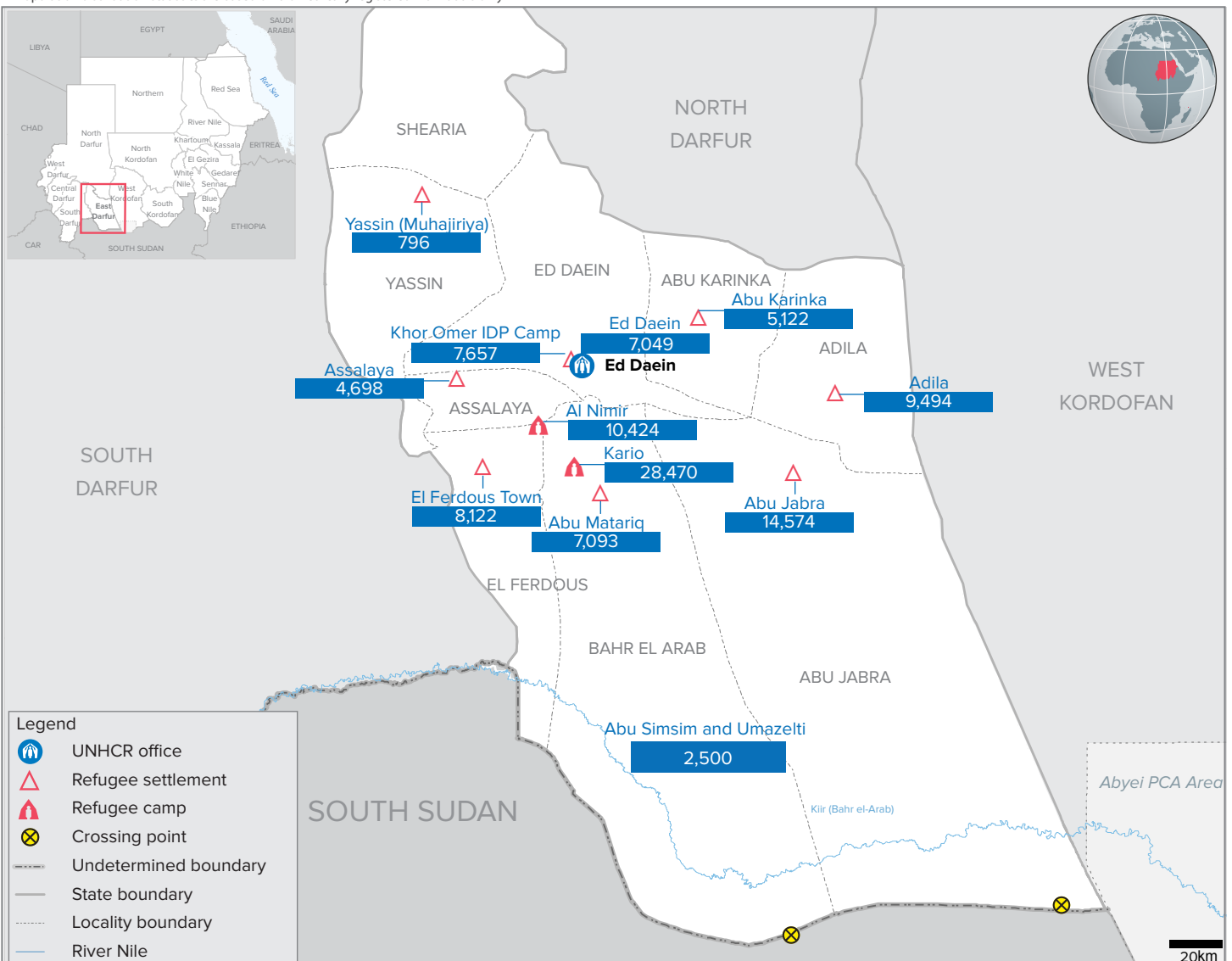
REPRODUCTIVE-AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)**

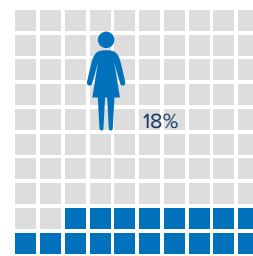
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN **



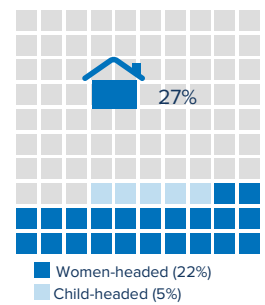
SCHOOL- AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) **



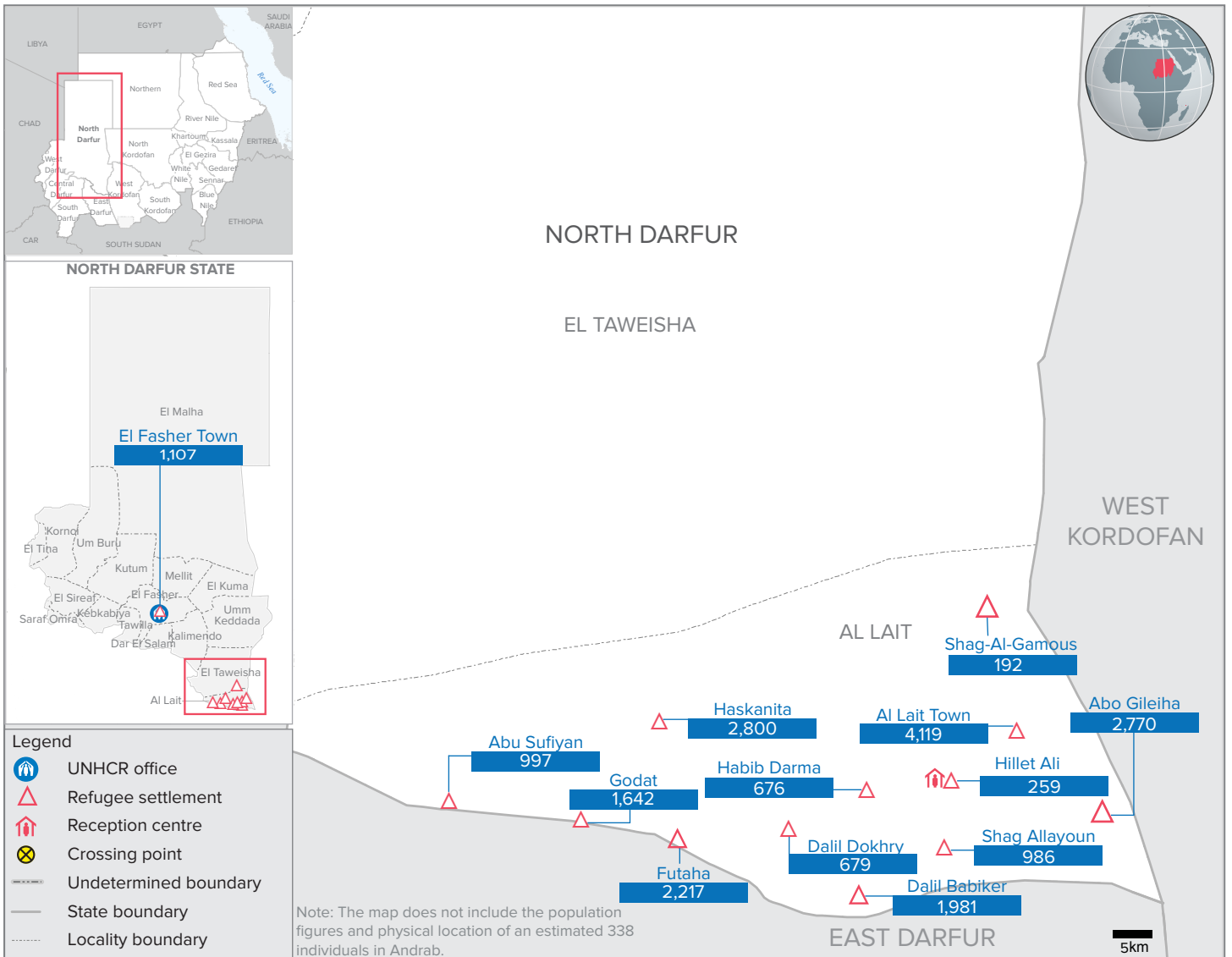
REPRODUCTIVE-AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)**

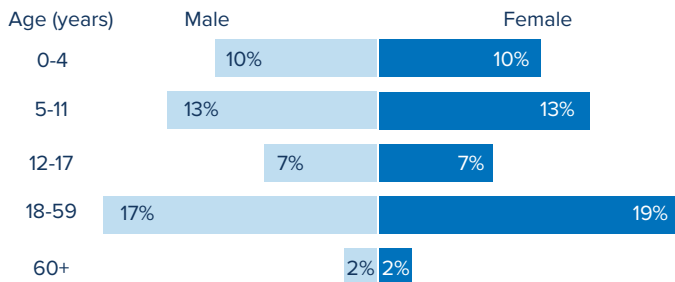

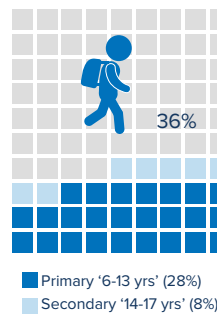
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION



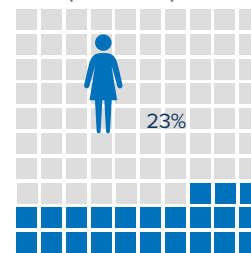
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN **



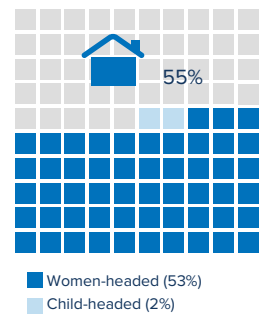
SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) **



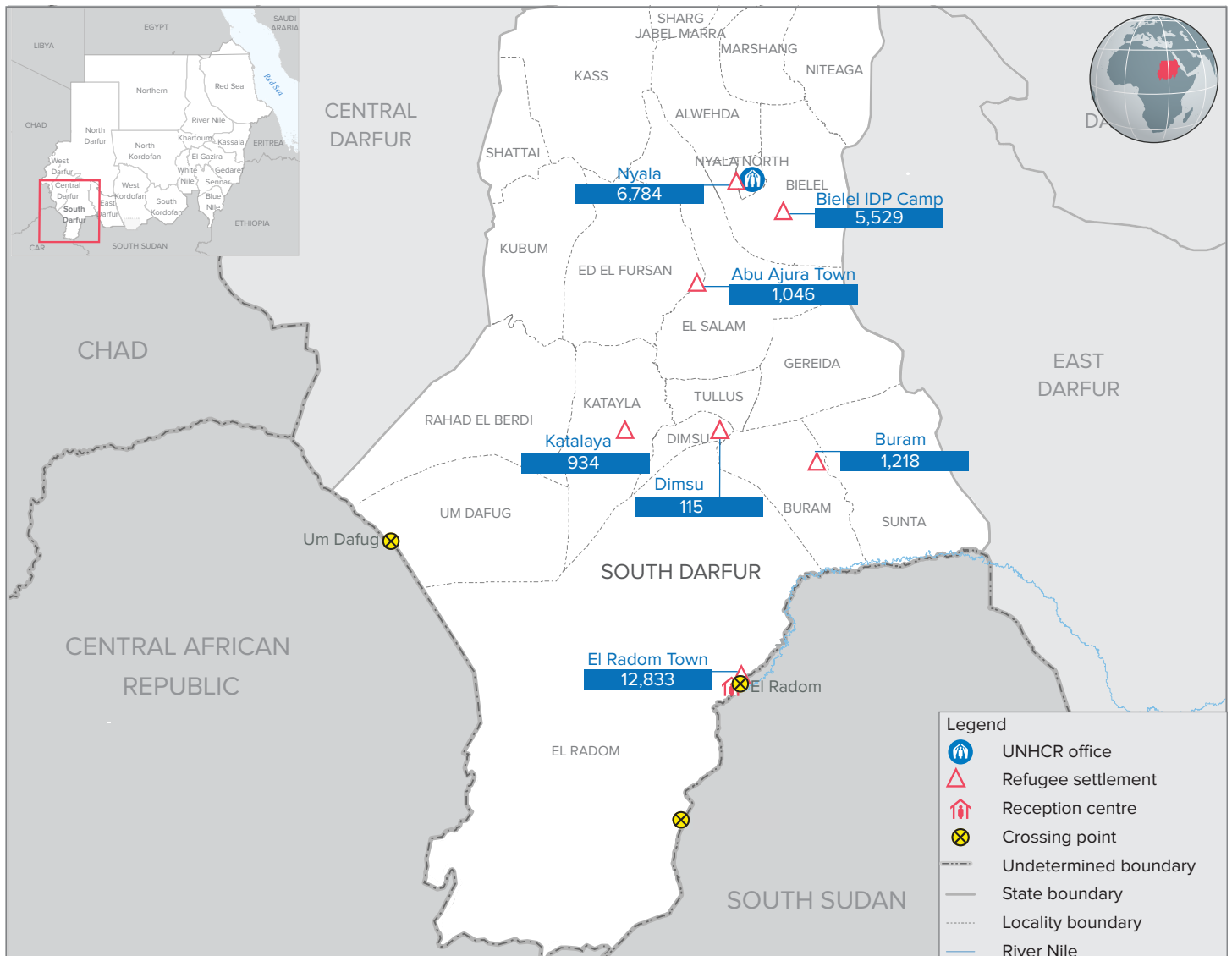

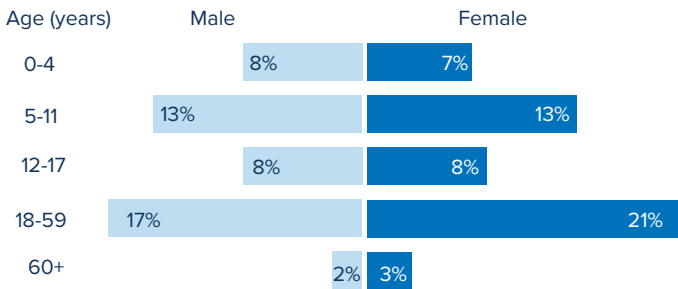

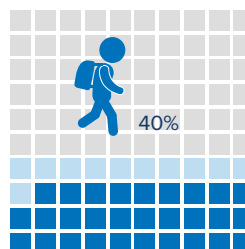

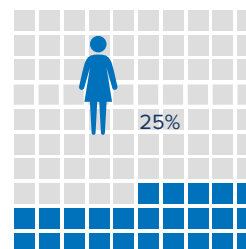
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN **



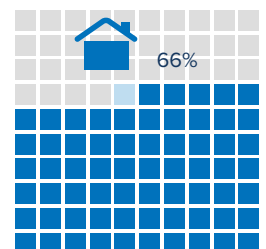

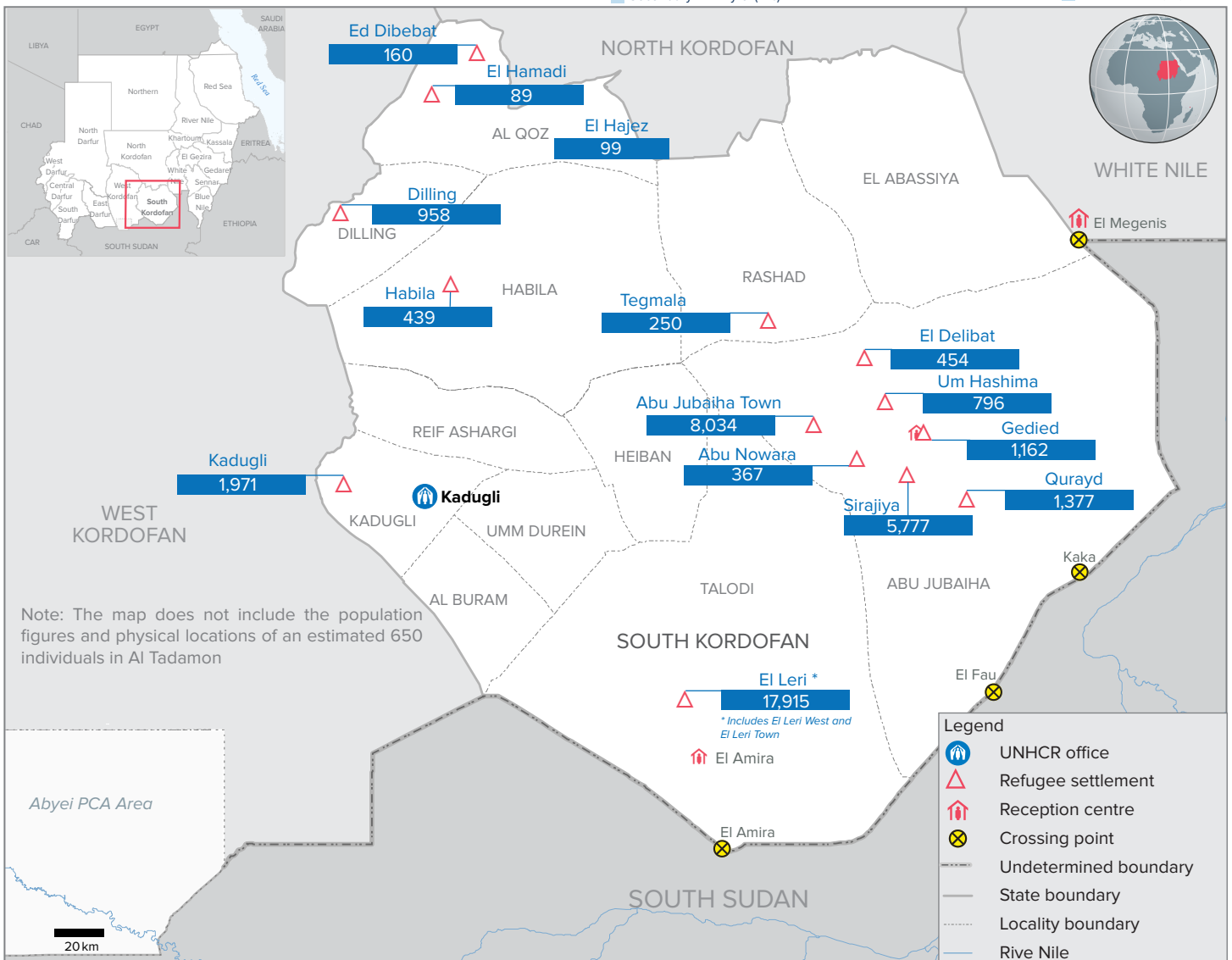
REPRODUCTIVE-AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)**

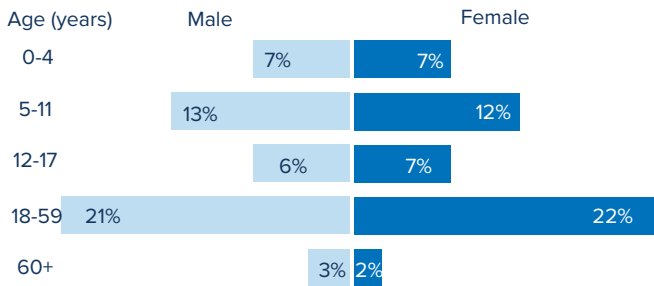

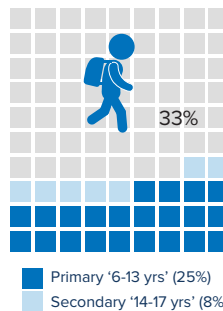

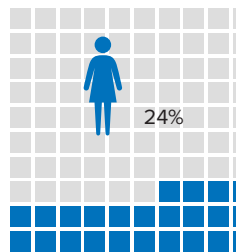
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN **



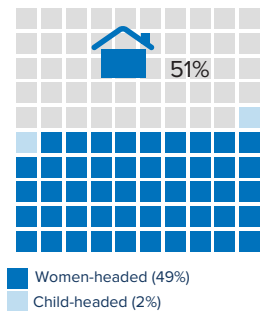

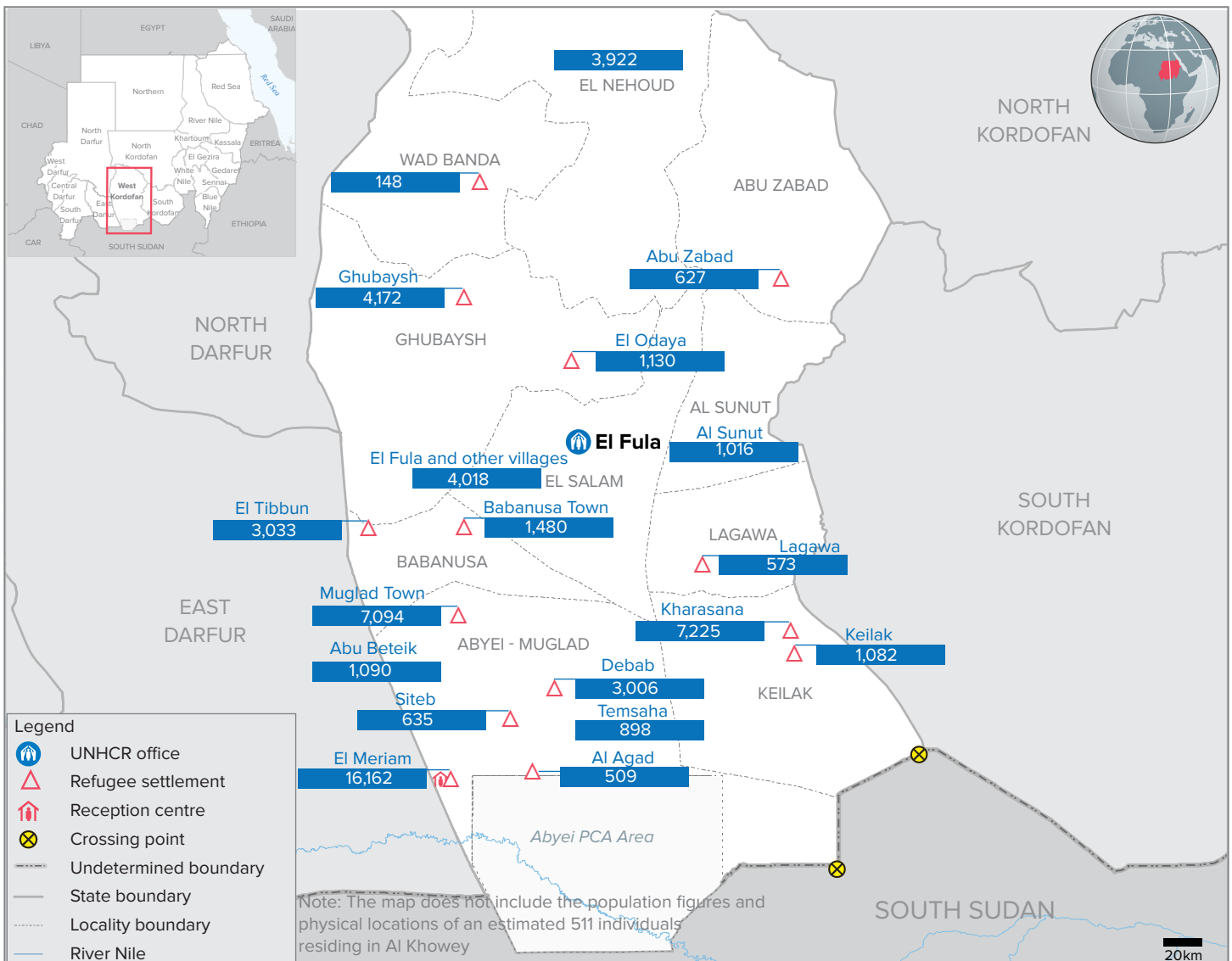
REPRODUCTIVE-AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)**

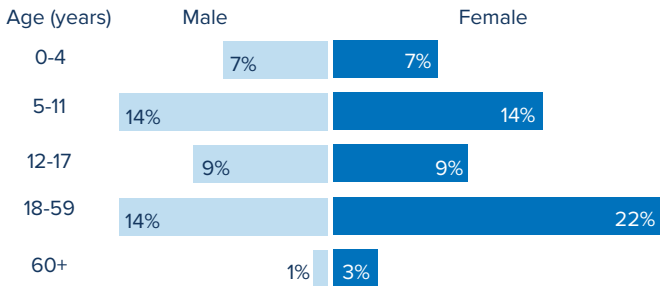

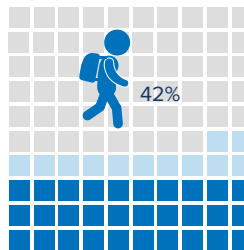

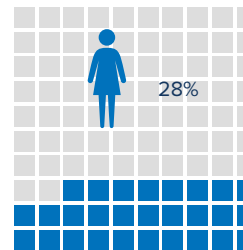
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN **



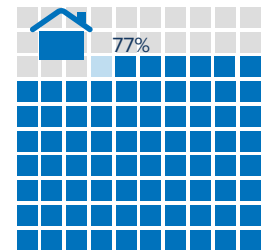
SCHOOL- AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) **



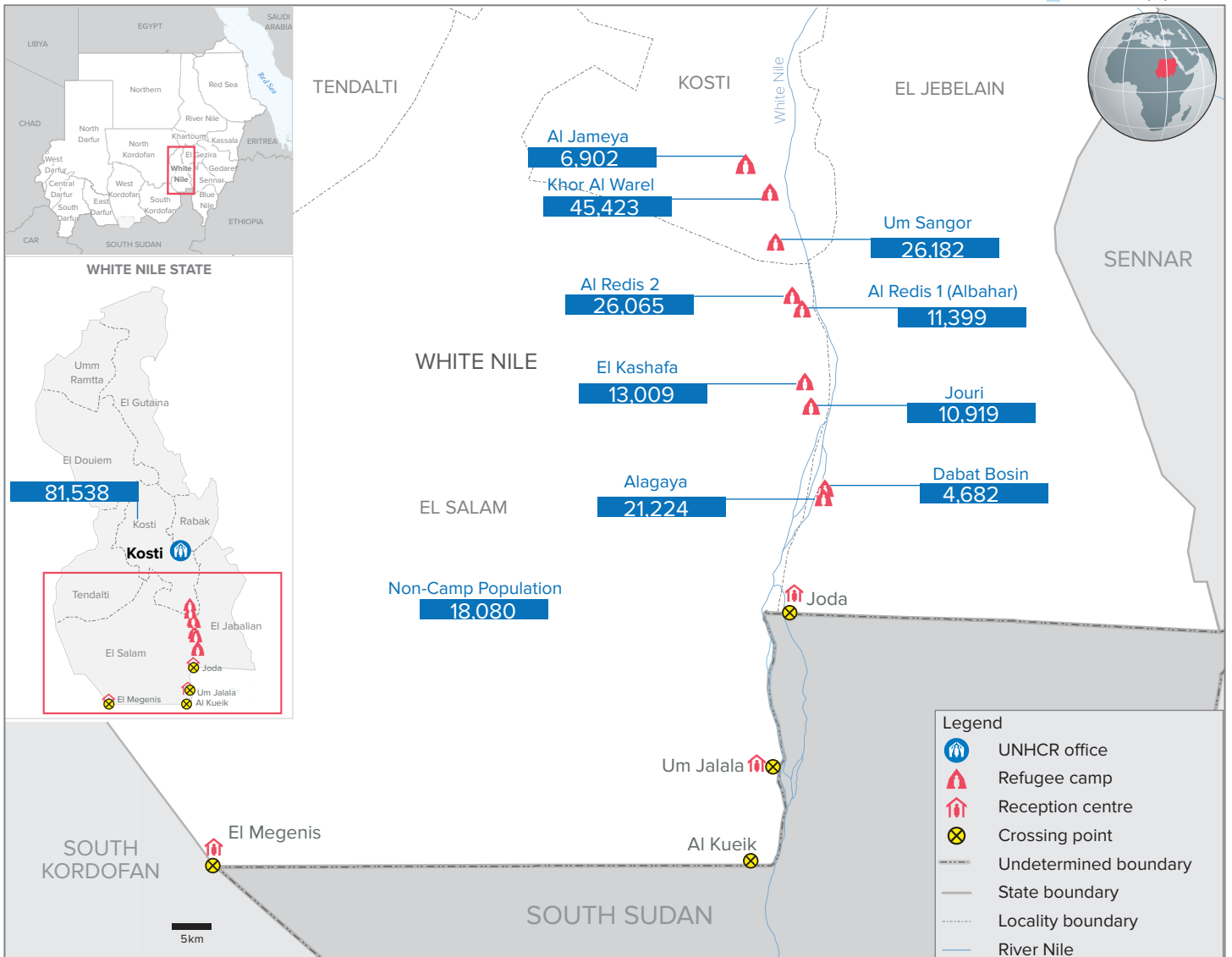
REPRODUCTIVE- AGED WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)**
