








Breakdown by Ethnicity

The Voluntary Repatriation Operations for the reported year started on 1 March 2019. 4,623 individuals facilitated for Voluntary Repatriation between 1 March to 30 September 2019 from Pakistan, out of 4,623 the total number of individuals entitled for cash assistance is 4,465. Remaining 158 received UNHCR's cash assistance in the past.




Women and Children of overall repatriation



In 2019, UNHCR prioritised funds for birth registration and the issuance of birth certificates to 70,000 children. The target for the issuance of individual PoR cards is 170,000 children who have reached five years of age and are eligible to receive their individual cards from the PCM centres.





