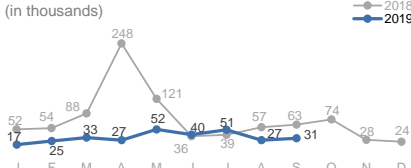

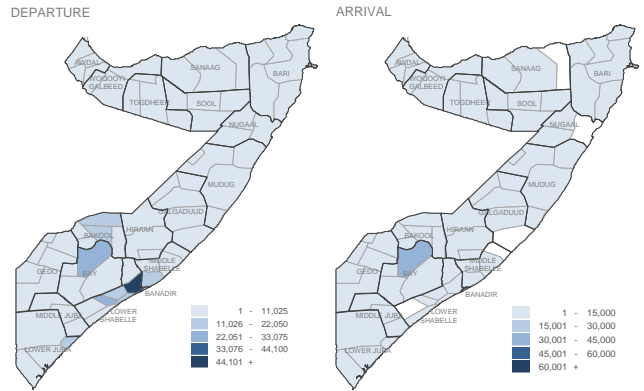
The UNHCR-led PRMN implemented in partnership with NRC reported 31,000 new internal displacements in the month of September 2019. Of these, 16,000 were triggered by conflict /insecurity, 14,000 related to drought related and 1,000 due to other reasons.

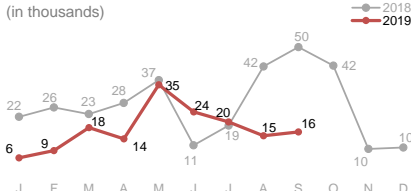

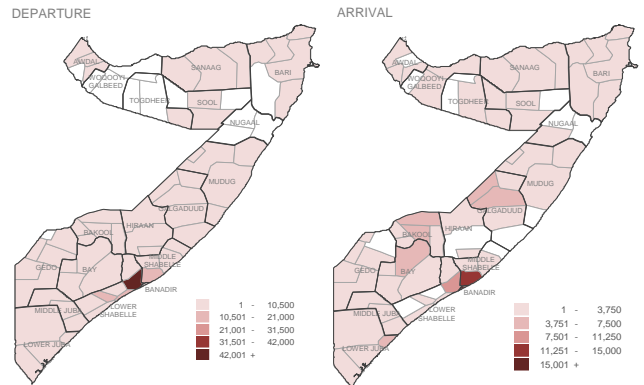

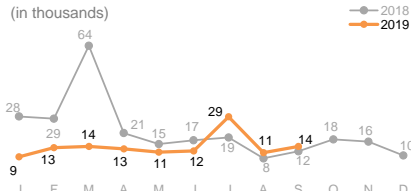

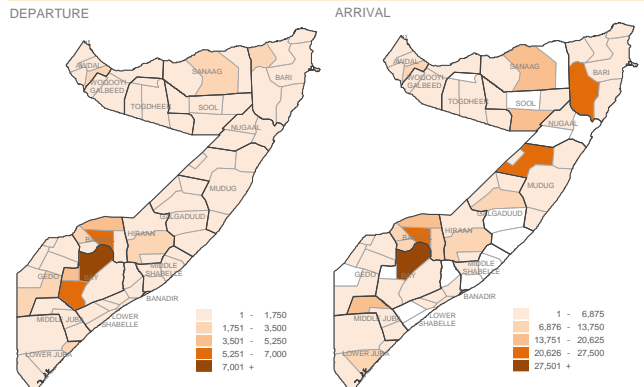
During the month of September, Bay (3,000) and Bakool (2,500) regions were the most affected by new displacements where the main reason given was drought or related lack of livelihoods.

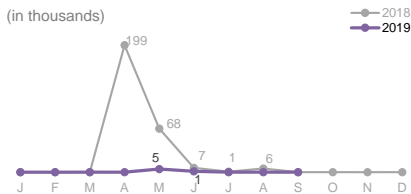

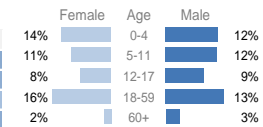
