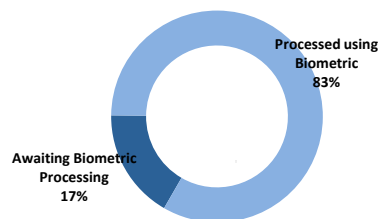

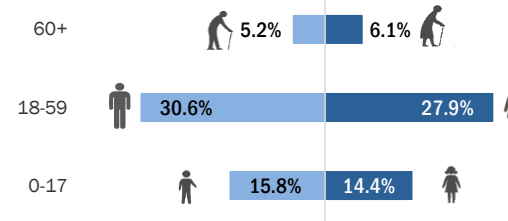

#### Age-Gender Breakdown

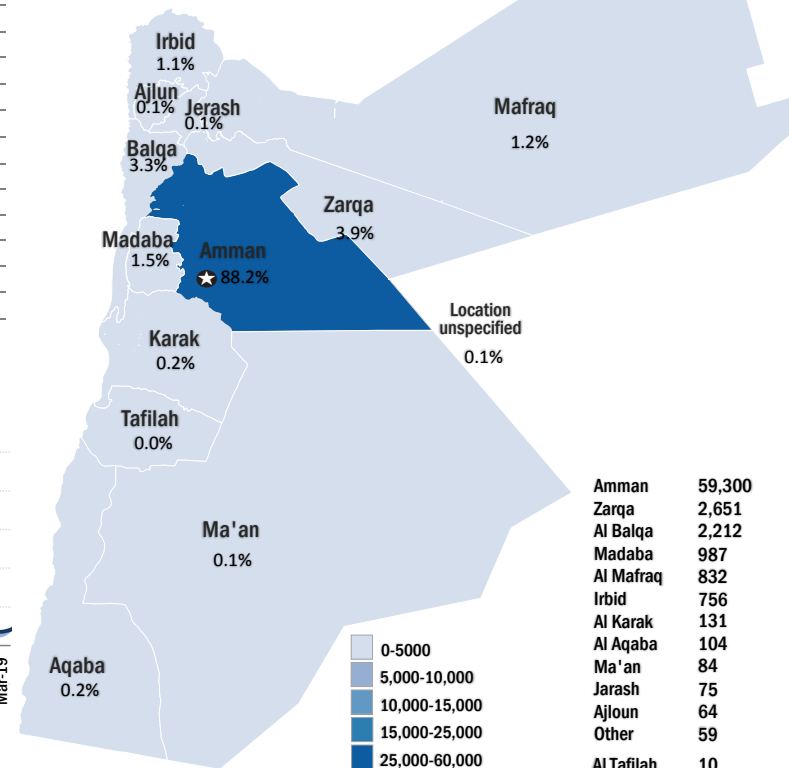
