	<p><i>accompany you; head to the ATM during daytime; avoid rush hours; select an ATM to use in a safe location; beware of strangers and those who may offer to help; make sure the surroundings of the ATM are clear from strangers before withdrawals and transactions; do not count your money in proximity to strangers; make sure to place the withdrawn amount in a safe place before leaving the ATM; if need be, seek the assistance of a bank employee only (during working hours); inform UNHCR about any security concern. Common PDM for Winterization – IOM	<p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Identify minimum core indicators relevant for broader analysis. - Provide partners with set of core indicators/questions to incorporate into PDM exercises. - Produce an overview of winterization cash assistance provided by partners in Jordan for the 2018-2019 season. <p>Approach:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Household-level questionnaires, Phone or in person. - Simple random sample of beneficiaries, 95% confidence interval, 5% margin of error. - Optional focus group discussion. <p>Next Steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Inputs from M&E colleagues to finalize core indicators. - Sharing of core indicators and related questions with partners. - Data collection by partners. - Compilation and analysis of common indicators. - Preparation of common PDM report?
