Partners Activities	<ul> <li>Partners gave a brief presentation of their current activities in the Shelter Sector.</li> <li>Habitat for Humanity talked about the 2 main projects that they are implementing to support refugees and host communities.</li> <li>Medair doesn't have a separate Shelter project, but they have a case management approach which incorporates a Shelter component in their programming.</li> <li>Caritas are implementing a cash for rent project and a rehabilitation project that focuses on winterization and warmer housing.</li> <li>IOCC's shelter component is mainly in Cash-for-Rent.</li> <li>UN-Habitat works in building the resilience in the cities and mainly focus SDG 11.</li> <li>IOM currently doesn't have a separate shelter project or component.</li> <li>IRW Shelter component mainly focuses on Cash-for-Rent.</li> <li>NRC implements shelter repair/construction in camps, Cash for Rent and a FLEX modality in Urban.</li> </ul>	All present partners
