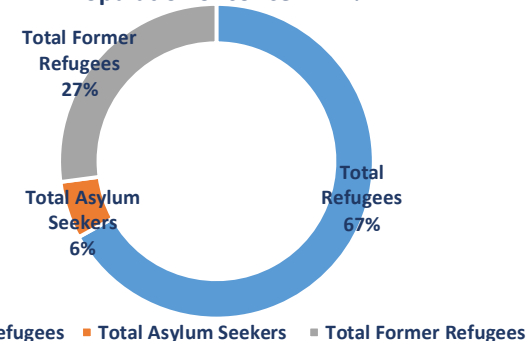

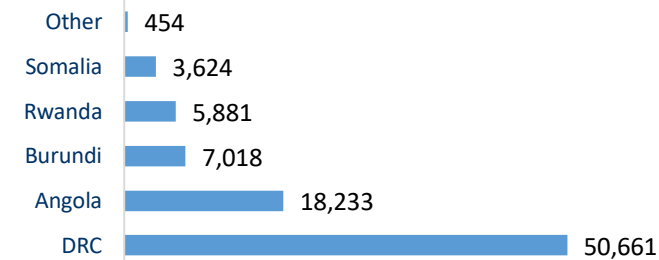

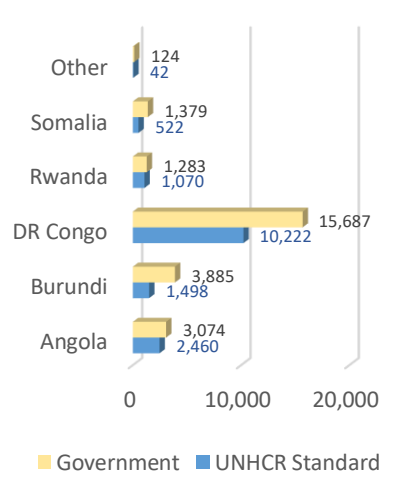

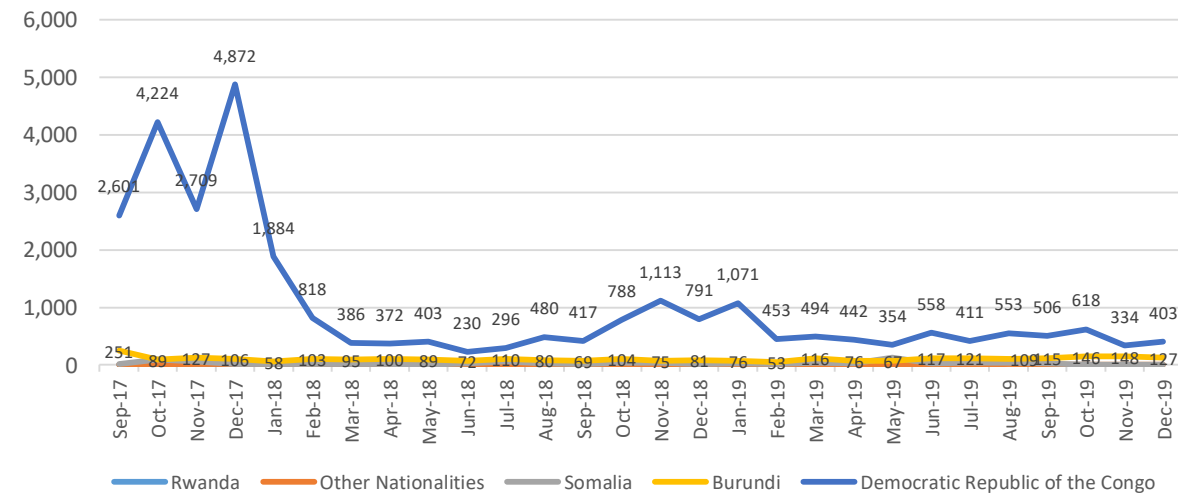

### Trend of New Arrivals by Nationality from Sept. 2017- Dec 2019

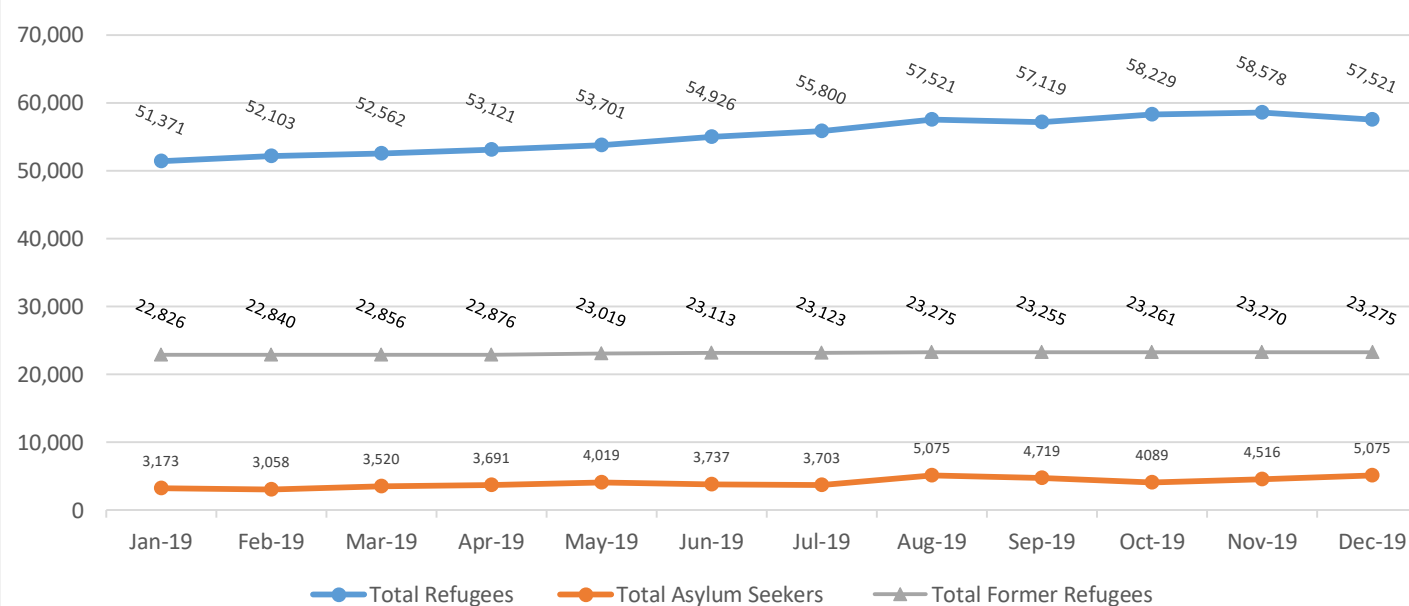

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Trend by legal status Jan-Dec 2019



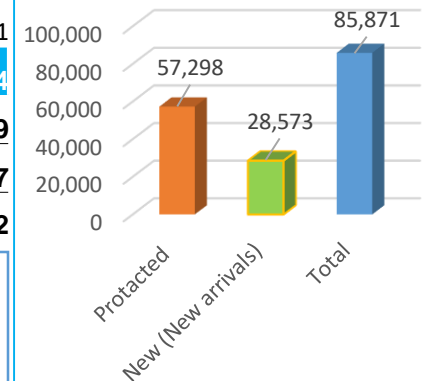

**Note** : from January 2017 to Date, a total of 47,282 individuals have been registered of which 39,987 still active and 7,295 are inactive/closed. Among 39,987 we have 28,573 registered as new arrivals, 4,678 registered as new Birth and 6,736 as In situ.

The 7,295 individuals inactive/closed we have 6,873 individuals registered as New arrivals, 204 as birth and 218 as in-situ.
