

Returns from Greece to Turkey

Overview


The majority of those returned to Turkey are **Pakistani nationals (35 percent of total)**. **Syrians** constitute **19 percent** of the total number of those returned, and are followed by **Algerians**, **Afghans** and **Iraqis**.

In total, **394 Syrians** have been returned to Turkey to date. **44** of them have been returned on the basis that their asylum claims were found inadmissible at 2nd instance.

Of all those returned, 43 percent did not express a will to apply for asylum or withdrew their will to apply for asylum or withdrew their asylum claims in Greece.


Return trend - February 2019 to February 2020




Total returns by age and gender April 2016 to 29 February 2020


April 2016 to 29 February 2020
