








Breakdown by Ethnicity

The Voluntary Repatriation Operations for the reported year started on 1 March 2019. 6,220 individuals facilitated for Voluntary Repatriation between 1 March to 30 November 2019 from Pakistan, out of 6,220 the total number of individuals entitled for cash assistance is 6,035. Remaining 185 received UNHCR's cash assistance in the past. Voluntary repatriation for the reported year has been suspended from 1 December till 29 February 2020 due to winter break.




Women and Children of overall repatriation



In 2020, UNHCR prioritised funds for birth registration and the issuance of birth certificates to 25,000 children. The target for the issuance of individual PoR cards is 185,000 children who have reached five years of age and are eligible to receive their individual cards from the PCM centres.






Arrest / detention by locations
