## Refugee returnees to Somalia at 29 February 2020



This figure includes Voluntary Repatriation from Kenya (84,974) and Assisted Spontaneous Returnees (ASR) from Yemen (5,221) as well as 1,478 returnees from other countries such as Djibouti (822), Libya (467), Sudan (143), Eritrea (34), Angola, Tunisia, Gambia, China, Cambodia and others. Somali refugees from these or other countries who return spontaneously without assistance from UNHCR are not included.



### RETURNEES FROM KENYA BY MONTH



### ASR RETURNEES FROM YEMEN BY MONTH


