The East and Horn of Africa and Great Lakes region is host to some 4.6 million refugees and asylum seekers, the majority (2.2 million) from South Sudan. A further 8.1 million people are internally displaced in the region, as a result of conflict and natural disasters. Some 126,900 refugees returned to their countries of origin in 2019, with 2020 figures be provided in future updates. to






