

Cumulative number of reported refugee returnees since Nov 2107, of which 205,795 returend following the of signing the revitalized peace agreement in October 2018.


In coordination with the office of the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC), UNHCR and its partners triangulate received reports at community level in areas of return through focus group discussion, key informant intervew as well as through meetings with traditional community leaders, religious leaders, representatives of local administration and law enforcement authorities coupled with the observations by the monitoring teams.

# Spontaneous refugee returnees by Country of Asylum



\*\*\* 25,488 is the overall July and August returns including those who had arrived early within the year but were verified in July & August and out of which 6,144 returned in July and August mainly from Uganda, Sudan and Ehtiopia to Eastern Equatorai (Magwi county), Unity (mainly Rubkona county) and Upper Nile (manily Maiwut, Fashoda and Panyikang counties)
