

Interpretation

Tongo Camp was opened by UNHCR on 5th October 2011. Since September 2011 thousands of civilians have fled the fighting in Blue Nile state of Sudan. UNHCR provides protection and monitors the delivery of services, while camp management is done by ARRA (Ethiopia's Administration for Refugee and Returnee Affairs) with support of UNHCR. This map shows population and infrastructure in surroundings of Tongo Camp and extent of clusters of tents based on analysis of QuickBird satellite image of November 30, 2011.

All visually interpreted features are captured with best effort but in some cases may not be complete.
