# **CCCM Cluster**



### **General update**

CCCM partners continue to provide inclusive COVID-19 awareness activities at the IDP site-level focusing on best practices for mitigating the spread of COVID-19. Partners reached a total of 921 IDP sites out of 2344 IDP sites nationally, covering 1,091,009 persons (42% out of total 2.6 million). Partners continue to distribute COVID-19 information leaflets to communities and to hold information sessions with members of the IDP community.


Partners targeted 453 IDP sites with cash-for-work activities aimed at improving living conditions in IDP settlements. Activities such as site cleaning and rehabilitation of communal infrastructures were carried out by community groups in Baidoa and Hudur.

Eviction risk mapping data collection by Kismayu CCCM partners identified particular IDP sites facing eviction notice. Through collaboration with local authorities, new sites were provided for affected households to relocate

Partners provided inclusive capacity development trainings for 330 Camp Management Committee (CMC) members, of which 56% were female.

Flood impact assessments conducted by CCCM partners noted more than 500 households living in Baidoa and Benadir were affected by the recent heavy rains. Partners provided flood mitigation awareness sessions with affected communities, and supported community members in establishing and rehabilitating drainage systems within IDP sites.





#### **Overall Objective**

To improve the living conditions and protection of IDPs in sites and settlements and ensure equitable access to services and assistance of all persons in need, with a clear focus on moving toward attaining durable solutions with full participation of the displaced and host communities.

#### Gaps

- Restricted humanitarian access in some parts of south and central Somalia
- Lack of information on service provision at site level
- Lack of land tenure and forced evictions inhibit the ability of partners to improve living conditions in sites
- Low levels of community participation and AAP inhibit ability to improve beneficiary targeting to include marginalized populations
- COVID-19 pandemic creating changes in service modalities and the need to prioritize risk communication activities over traditional CCCM tasks
