

FACT SHEET

Somalia

1 - 30 November 2020

In November, 151,000 new internal displacements were monitored by the UNHCR-led Protection and Returns Monitoring Network (PRMN). Drivers include flood (79,000), drought-related (57,000), conflict and insecurity (13,000) and Other (2,000).



As of the reporting month, there were 24,073 refugees and asylum-seekers registered in Somalia, mainly from Ethiopia (12,815 asylum seekers and 4,163 refugees) and Yemen (6,309 refugees). 786 persons were from other countries including Syria (545), Tanzania (118), Eritrea (83) among others.

The floods have persisted into November as Deyr season (Sep - Nov) ended. Lower Shabelle (49,000), Banadir (12,000) and Middle Shabelle (9,000) regions were the most affected by the floods

91,832 refugee returnees (2014 - 2020)

Since December 2014, 91,832 Somali refugees have voluntarily returned to Somalia with UNHCR assistance from different countries of asylum including Kenya, Yemen, Djibouti, Libya, Sudan and Eritrea. In addition, some 39,160 Somalis were monitored as arriving from Yemen since March 2015.
