



SECTOR ACHIEVEMENTS

During 2020, sector partners provided extensive basic needs assistance through cash-based interventions and in-kind support to alleviate negative impact of pandemic on the most vulnerable households. Total number of basic assistance beneficiaries reached to 3.8 million, which increased by 80 percent compared to previous year. Programs which were reported under basic needs sector by 23 different organisations focused on provinces of Southeast Turkey and metropolitan cities including Istanbul, Ankara, and Izmir. Majority of the sectoral activities under refugee component surpassed the annual planning targets resulting from partners reallocating current resources and raising funding through Covid-19 ad-hoc appeal.

By the end of the year, over 2 million refugees benefited from cash-based interventions including regular monthly cash and one-off cash schemes. The Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN) programme supported over 317 thousand households in meeting their daily needs through multi-purpose monthly cash assistance and reached 1.8 million individuals. Partners provided complementary cash-based assistance and reached to over 172 thousand individuals in 2020.

Provision of gender-appropriate hygiene, dignity and sanitary items continued in the last quarter; in addition, partners retroactively reported for the second and third quarters. Consequently, total number of beneficiaries through this activity reached over 1.5 million individuals by the end of year. Number of partners reporting distribution of gender-appropriate hygiene, dignity and sanitary items increased from 3 in 2019 to 18 in 2020.

Number of beneficiaries of food assistance modalities including in-kind and restricted cash remained the same with previous quarter, partners reaching nearly 180 thousand individuals. Monthly food assistance program in TACs continued; yet, no new activity was reported in the urban context in the last quarter. Shelter activities reached to over 10 thousand individuals by the end of the year; sector reached only 30 percent of its annual target through this modality due to underfunding and restrictions due to pandemic. Support of the sector to public institutions and municipalities significantly increased in 2020. Partners provided support to technical capacities of 56 municipalities to deliver municipal services. In addition, 36 municipalities were supported with newly established municipal infrastructure to expand capacity for service delivery.

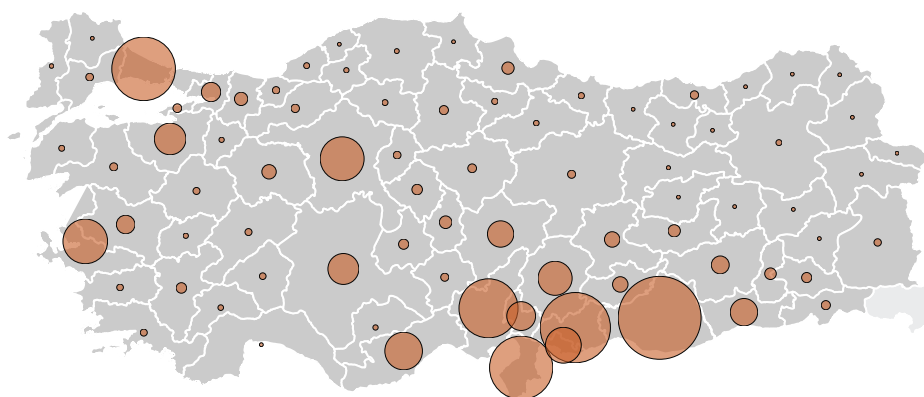

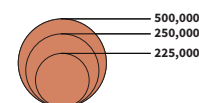
