Update from LWF on Adjumani & MRE materials	LWF provided an update on the UXO incident that occurred in Adjumani, Maaji refugee settlement on 17 February. A total of 11 children were affected with 8 deaths. LWF provided case management and psychosocial support services. Since the incident 4 more UXOs have been found in the area. LWF is developing a number of awareness-raising materials, these will be shared with sector partners for review and feedback by next week.	LWF to share materials for review	Lydia/LWF

Update on CP assessment	UNICEF and UNHCR have met with REACH initiative to see a potential for collaboration on technical support. We are currently awaiting feedback from REACH to see additional or external resources. The idea would be that the data collection will be done through CP sector members, while REACH would maybe assist with e.g. developing the methodology, conducting the data analysis, drafting the final report.
