









Place of Residence (Individuals)


Arrivals (12-month trends)

*In August 2020, there was a decrease of 8,265 refugee and asylum seekers individuals due to spontaneous departure (25 persons), deaths and other closures (8 persons) and 8,232 persons were inactivated because of no-show during BIMS verification exercise as opposed to an increase of newly registered 16 refugees and asylum-seekers and 8 new-born babies (12 Syrians, 7 Ethiopians, and 5 Yemenis).
