The monthly dashboard summarizes the progress made by partners involved in the Lebanon Crisis Response Plan (LCRP) and highlights trends affecting people in need.

Partners in Lebanon are working to: **1)** ensure protection of vulnerable populations; **2)** provide immediate assistance to vulnerable populations; **3)** support service provision through national systems; and **4)** reinforce Lebanon's economic, social, institutional and environmental stability. 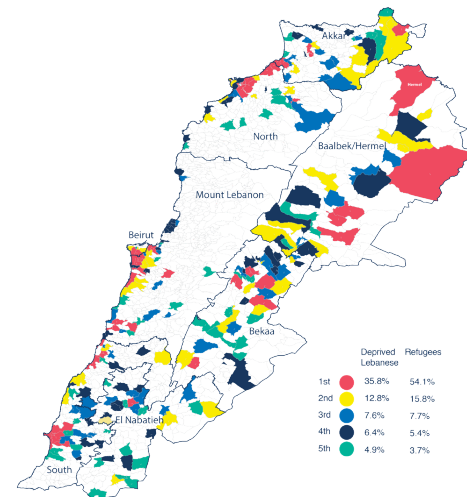

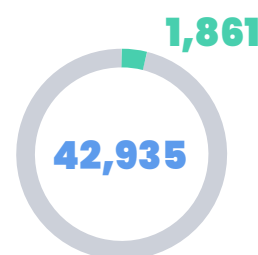

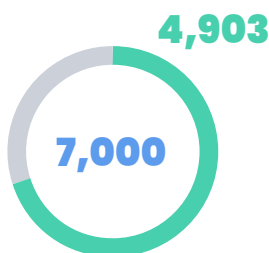

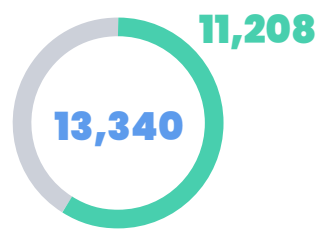

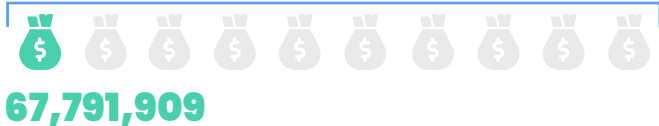
