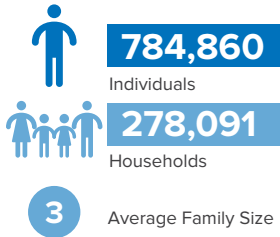
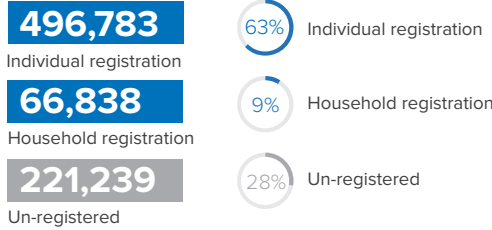


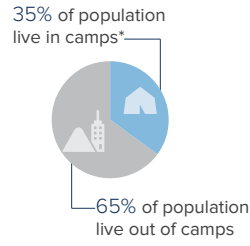

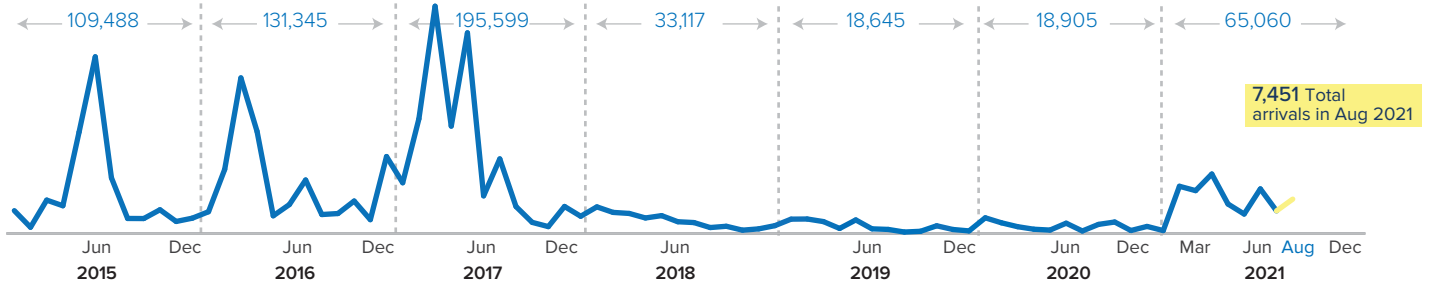

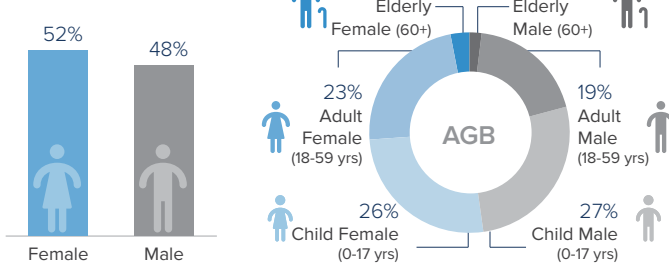

Monthly Arrival Trends (2015-2021)



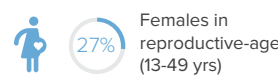

Age-gender Breakdown²

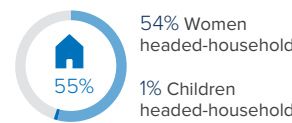

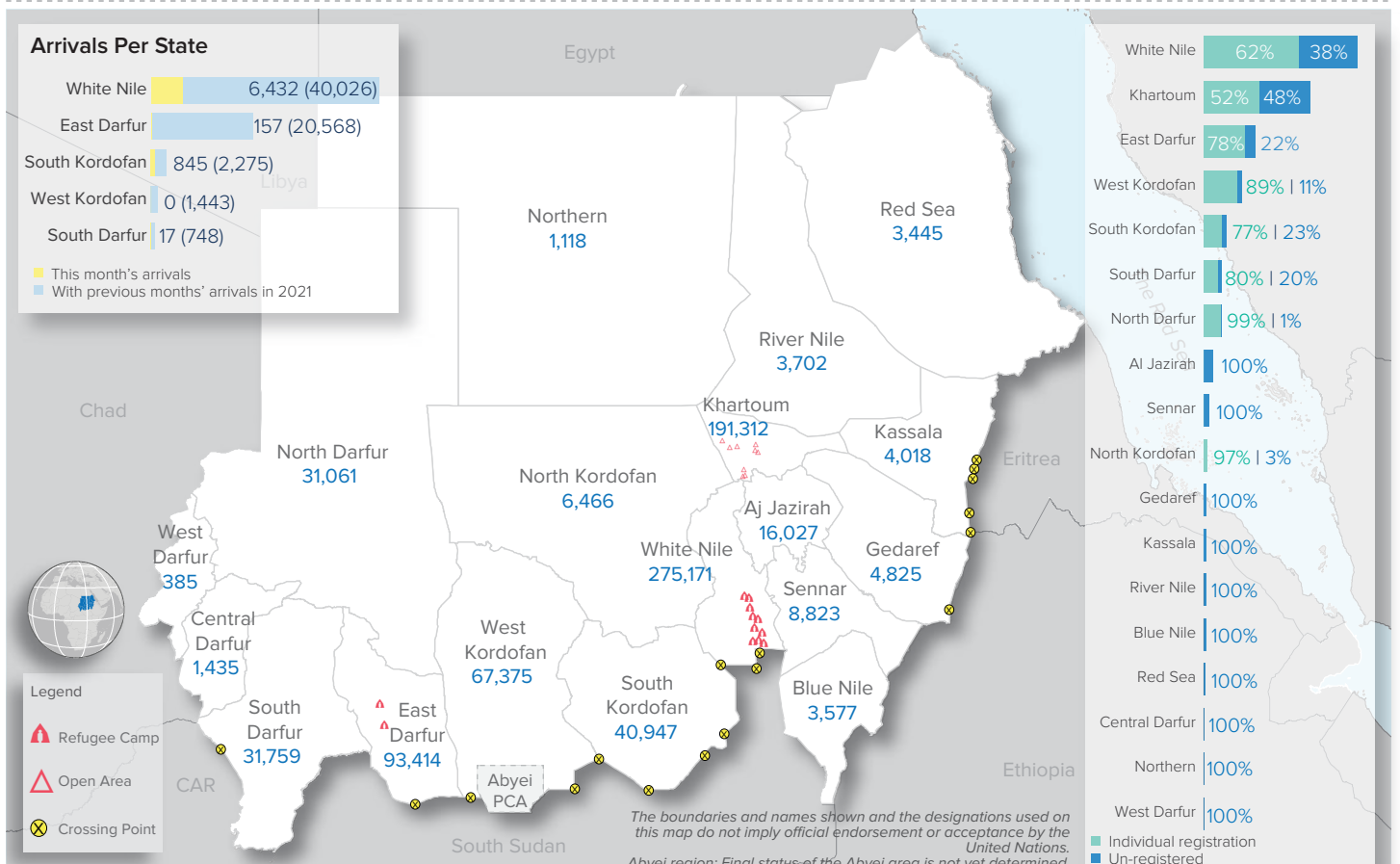
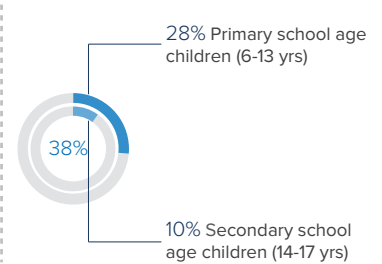
Reproductive-age Women/Girls²
