





Al-Ghayl, Al-Hazm and Al-Maton Districts Returnees Report

Al-Jawf Governorate

Introduction:

There has been many cases of returning for the IDPs who were displaced to different locations to their residences in Al-Jawf governorate. Of those, there were those who returned to their places in three districts in Al-Jawf, namely Al-Hazm, Al-Ghayl, and Al-Maton districts.

Those who have returned to Al-Hazm district were displaced in Al-Maton, Khab wa Sha'af, Az Zahir districts, Ma'rib, and Sana'a Governorates. As for those who returned to Al-Maton district were displaced in Al-Hazm, Az-Zahir districts and Sana'a governorate. In regards to those who returned to Al-Ghayl district, they were displaced in Az-Zahir district, Ma'rib and Sana'a governorates.

In regards to number of these returnees in the three districts of Al-Ghayl, Al-Maton, and Al-Hazm, the numbers are different in each district.

Situation of these returnees:

The situation of these returnees can be detailed in that many of them returned to their houses and they are destroyed. In addition, some of them returned to their district to find themselves lacking the basic life need of shelter. They could not protect themselves against the harsh weather of Al-Jawf that at least requires shelter against rain and the heat of the sun.

Current need of these returnees:

It is noted that some of these returnees have been targeted with the NFIs distribution assistance. Even though some of these returnees have been aided with the IDPs community center services, they are still in need of further assistance. These returnees are in dire need of shelter. This can be helped through the intervention of tents and others by rehabilitating their house through C4W modality. They are additionally in need of food assistance as they have conveyed this need, which a basic human being right.
