


### **VERIFIED IDP SITES IN DIINSOOR AS OF OCTOBER 2021**


Map of verified IDP sites in Diinsoor - October 2021

#### **Assessment overview**

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Diinsoor in October 2021 led by SWSCRI and UNHCR. 12 IDP sites were identified hosting 2,969 households or 17,814 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in April 2021, there was an increase of 1 IDP site, 1,624 Households or 9,744 individuals.

# People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were

73 (44% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

**93** (62% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid) 81 (32% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

**88** (66% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

58 (47% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

64 (41% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

# **Eviction Risk Mapping**

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been

17% of IDP sites have been classified

100% of sites have Communal ownership/permanent ownership type of land tenure

8% of sites have no agreement in place

100% of those that have agreements have oral agreements


100% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates

17% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months
