Preconditions for EMT deployments

- ▶ EMTs - receive the MoH accreditation to work!!!
- Professionals Medical doctors, nurses, paramedics - Russian/Ukrainian/Romania languages speaking;
 - Fully equipped with medicines, consumables and devices
 - Follow the international & national clinical treatment protocols - continuity of care
 - Follow the national referral system
 - Document their support (medical forms) and
 - Reporting in the national databases and EMT coordinators
- EMT are equipped with cars and ensure mobility for the team
- Work under MoH/Local Med team coordination

Scenarios - Phases (contingency plan)

- ▶ I phase - EMT at the
 - Refugee camps level
 - PoE
 - community level (TBC)
- ▶ II phase - Health care facility levels:
 - Primary health care
 - Hospital care
 - Ambulance care - **based on the EXCEPTIONAL scenario**

I phase - after MoH accreditation letter

- refugee camps
- points of entry (outside) TBC
