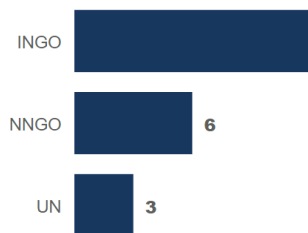

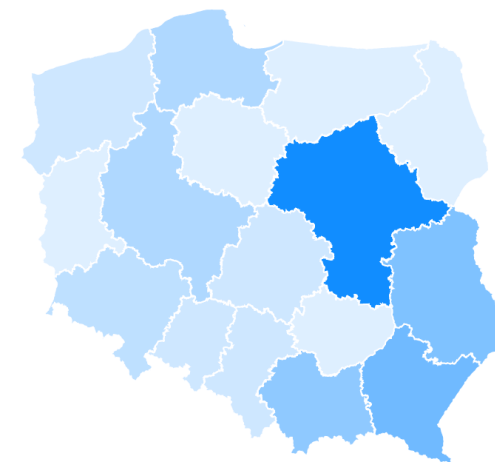

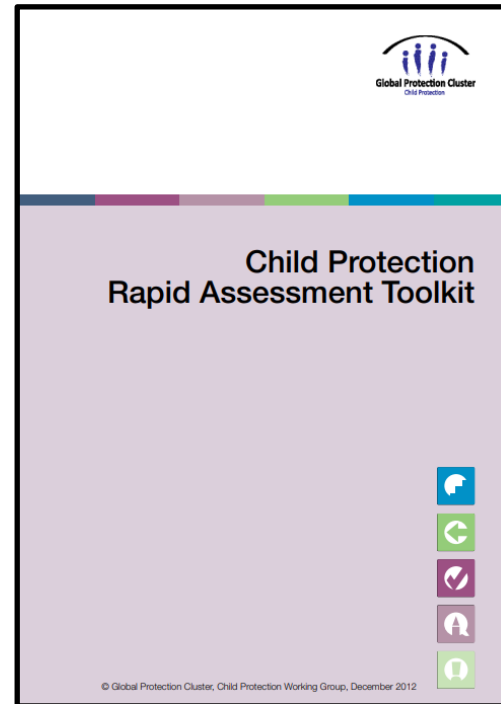

  - Volunteers from the CP SWG to work on an outline areas of interest/questions

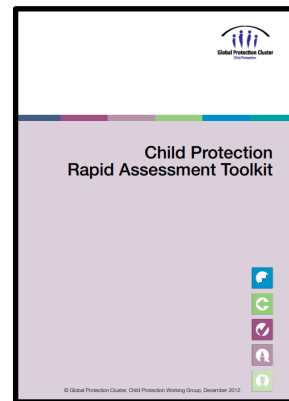
# Child Protection Rapid Assessment

- For Child Protection: global framework is the CPRA – Child protection rapid assessment toolkit
- CPRA is an inter-agency, sector-specific rapid assessment for use by CPSWG members in the aftermath of a rapid-onset emergency.
- Builds on the initial multi-sector joint assessment(s) and the protection sector rapid assessment.
- Snapshot of urgent child protection related needs among the affected population
- It can also act as a stepping-stone for a more comprehensive process of assessing the impacts of the emergency on children, as well as situation monitoring.
