



UNHCR Moldova: Cash Assistance for Refugees

UNHCR provides cash assistance to refugees coming from Ukraine in Moldova. Cash assistance enables vulnerable households to meet their basic needs, mitigates protection risks including use of harmful coping mechanism. Cash assistance directly supports Moldovan economy and boosts the local markets.



CRITERIA FOR IDENTIFICATION OF BENEFICIARIES

Persons who fled Ukraine can be considered for the grant. They can be Ukrainian nationals or citizens of other countries who were residing in Ukraine. Households and people with the following characteristics are eligible for the grant:

(1) Household with one or more dependents (2) Household headed by a single parent (3) Household headed by a child (below 18) (4) Household with an unaccompanied or separated child (5) Household headed by an older person (above 60) (6) Household with one or more persons with specific needs, including: Person with a disability, Pregnant woman, Person with a serious medical condition, woman at risk, person with legal and physical protection needs, LGBTI.

8 Protection Help Desks to identify persons with specific needs, assess their vulnerability, provide assistance and refer to appropriate services where needed.
