

Relief



Main highlights

- UNHCR supply service works closely with partners to ensure speedy and agile service to the stakeholders.
- UNHCR has played a key leadership and coordination role in supply and logistics in Moldova.
- UNHCR worked to ensure effective and timely delivery of goods for the refugee response in Moldova.
- UNHCR will continue to pre-position CRI through HQ and Regional stockpiles in different countries.
- UNHCR maintains two warehouses and maintains a pre-positioned stock of Core Relief Items (CRI) for emergency deployment.

Achievements

- UNHCR managed to preposition core relief items in two warehouses with 4,800 m² capacity.
- UNHCR dispatched over 80 Purchase Orders (POs) with a total value of USD 1.5 million.
- UNHCR established 33 Frame Agreements (FAs) and Service Contracts for goods and services.
- UNHCR processed seven Transfer of Ownership Agreements and one Right of Use Agreement (CRS).
- UNHCR obtained tax exemption and prompt customs clearance for all CRIs imported in Moldova.

Challenges

- Lack of local availability of CRIs necessitates their import from international sources.
- Global supply chain disruptions affect the prompt delivery of shipments.
