

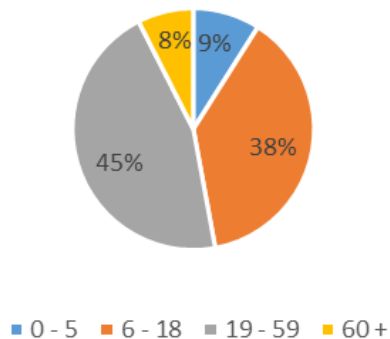

Action Santé Femmes (ASF), Maurane MARGRAFF

- working on women’s health improvement around the globe
- following the current situation in Ukraine and as mainly the refugees are women and children, ASF deployed a mobile gynecology-obstetrics consultation unit in Poland, to intervene with these women and their newborns to provide them with healthcare (one midwife and one gynecologist on two-week missions). Location: first - Przemysl (in Tesco camp), now - Warsaw (in Ptak camp) as the needs were decreasing.
