UNICEF</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• UNICEF provides coordination and leadership to the WASH response iin coordination and collaboration of Governmnt of Moldova and UNHCR. Several bilateral coordination meetings with UNHCR and visits to the sites are done to ensure coordinated and effective response.</li> <li>• UNICEF has signed partnership with SI and Moldova for Peace to provide WASH response and contingency response for rehabilitation and improvement of WASH services in BDs, RACs and host families.</li> <li>• Ongoing Procurment of 19 sanitary containers of different designs that wil be installed in te different locations at BDs or RACs. Some will be stored as contingency.</li> </ul> <p><b>2. - Assessment of contingency RACs with 26 are identified and additional existing as schools will be concluded shortly.
- Around 4000 refugee are existing presently in the RACs and 3000 can be accommodated in case needed.

### 3. ACTED/IP of UNHCR

- There are 3 types of RACS: Operational, closed and frozen
- Provides and manage transportation and sanitation facilities at Bus Stations and the 90 RACs.

### 4. NRC

- Presently conducting an assessment for shelter and cash assistance in collective centres

### 5. SKAT- Swiss Resource Centre and Cnsultancies for Development

- Working on humanitarian WAHS project to improve sanitation services for 600 Households. Communication is ongoing with 150 muncilapity. The criteria is families hosted for 2-3 weekes

### 6. SI/UNICEF IP

- Working on installation sanitary containers in BDs and RACS
- Communication to rent some containers for immediate installation through local vendors
- Clarifcation on RAC in Otaaci( AP)

### 7. IMC

- IMC moved to the south to support on evolving situation in Ukraine
- IMC has contingency stock in Moldova

### 8. MfP-Moldova for Peace/UNICEF IP.

- Distribution 1500 HK per week; 4-5k person/week
- Managing the registration platform. "Moldova for Peace" created an easy and quick system based on the online platform <https://www.dopomoha.md/> through which the refugees can request the necessary items and redeem them based on a code. It is also connected with the emergency and green lines.

### 3. National Contingency Plan

Government of Moldova is developing a Contingency Plan to repond in case a mass influx of refugees coming from Ukraine takes place. The Government of Moldova is planning their contingency response based on their current capacity. However, in case the situation exceeds the existing capacity, complementarity might be need from partners including NGOs, INGOs, UN Agencies, among others.

In light of this, the Refugee Coordination Forum is mapping the preparedness capacities of sectors and its members to respond to an eventual situation of mass influx, including preparedness measures and emergency response activities that could be quickly implemented if needed.
